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Participants: male and female Judoka with intellectual disability in the levels class 1 and 2 with a valid sports health certificate.

Year of birth 2001 and older

Level Class I:

Judoka who can participate in a training/competition with mainstream judoka and can anticipate well to judo techniques.

Level Class II:

Knowledge about the Judo Sport. The aim and goal of the competition is clear to the athletes. German participants need a valid DJB or DBS Starter Pass.

In addition:

Start of fights in Tachi-waza (standing position)

Persons who suffer beside the intellectual disability under permanent sickness, can not start if the sport could detestiorate their health extremely, such as people with implants,(f.e. artifisial joints, heart pacemaker etc.) or have just survived a heart attack. If weight categories show insufficiend competitors two categories can be joined.

Limit of participants 300: Each country can register up to 18 athletes (9 male and 9 female). If the maximum no. of participants in one weight category will not be reach the host country can register additional Judoka.

Sportive Management: Every nation provide one or more Referee with an IJF A - license

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- Each country who registers will accepted the “**International Competition Rules (Pilot)** “ with the registration.
- The Judokas should only appear with white Judogi.

Each Athlete has to be insured from/by his own federation. The host will take no liability.

Doping:

Doping is not permitted according to the anti-doping regulations of the Deutscher Behindertensportverband e.V. (DBS – NPC). The Anti Doping Code of the DBS and the rules of WADA, the IPC the NADA and on international events the rules of the national federation will apply. (see www.dbs-npc.de)

Controls can be mandated by the Anti Doping delegate from the DBS.

With registration the participants declare the acknowledgement of the anti-doping Regulations

If there are medicines prescribed and taken, a written down proof (= medical certificate) about these has to be carried with and to be presented if controlled.

For this reason all participants have to carry a listing of the taken medicines with medical indication, in order to be able to submit this list if necessary. If this indication proof is missing, the athlet can be punished in the case of a positive result.

Athletics who need substances for medical inclication which are listed of the WADA – Prohibited list have to exhibit a Therapeutic use Examption (TUE)

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Your registration is confirmed when you have paid the full registration fee in advance.
