Participating countries:

5 countries: Russia, Japan, Mongolia, China, South Korea

Age of participants:

under 18 years old (born in 2001-2003).

System competition:

Team competition. Mix team male & female. Each team contains 16 judokas, reserve athletes are allowed (2 judoka in each weight categories maximum).

Duration: 4 minutes. Golden Score: no time limit.

Competition system: Double repechage with 1 bronze medal.

Seeding – Medal winners of Mixed Team Cadet World Championships 2017 will be seeded.

The team that wins the most wins in individual fights win. If there are an equal number of wins (this is 4:4 for cadets) at the end of the match, a draw is done from all categories regardless if the team has a player or not (if both teams don't have a player in the same category, this category will not be included in draw). The athletes in the drawn category will refight a golden score contest.

Weight categories:

Male: -50, - 55, - 60, - 66, - 73, -81, - 90, +90 kg Female: -40, 44, -48, -52кг, -57, -63, -70, +70kg.

Weigh-in:

Athletes must present accreditation card and his/her passport (National ID Card showing nationality and date of birth are also accepted)

Competition rules:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules on 2 mats.

Draw:

There will not be a seeding of the strongest team.

Tournament mode:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules.

Judogi:

All Judoka must compete in IJF approved judogi.

Back numbers:

Each competitor taking part in the event is obliged to have sewn on the back of his Judogi

the official back number (IJF are allowed) bearing his surname and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation. The back number can be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com or www.ijfbacknumber.com (Attention: production and delivery may take around 4 weeks). The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.

Awarding:

All medal winners will be awarded with medals. All teams medals winners will be awarded with trophies.

The best judokas (1 male and 1 female) of the tournament will be awarded by the special prize from Yasuhiro Yamashita, Olympic champion, fourfold world champion, nine fold champion of Japan.

Training:

Tatami for training will be available on September 10th and September 11th from 8:00 till 20:00. Sport hall is located in the Campus of the Far Eastern Federal University (building S2)
