Hotel reservations must be made only through the organization of the continental open, based on availability as requested (all participants who need accreditation must be accommodated in the official hotel). Reservations at judoecuador2014@hotmail.com



The countries that do not accept the accommodation option offered by the organizing committee, will not be provided with transportation during their stay in the country and will have to pay 250.00 USD per competitor to cover organizational costs.

NOTE.- THE REQUIREMENT OF ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD IS FOR A MINIMUM PERIOD OF 3 DAYS , ANY CASE THE MÍNIMUM STAY IS 3 DAYS.

Reservations for hotels must be made until May 13, 2019. The total payment must be made until June 13, 2019, at the time of accreditation.

Those delegations of countries that can not make bank transfers should cancel in cash at the time of your accreditation, having complied in time with the inscription and formal reservations previously.

Possible extra room reservations at check-in will also be overcharged with 10% NO exception will be made.

Cancellation Costs: After May 13, the cancellation of rooms or **"NO SHOW"** will result in 100% of the cost of hotel expenses. The cancellations of the rooms can not be made in the check-in.

To optimize the accommodation and stay it is important to indicate the number of athletes and members of the delegation before May 13, 2019, **WITHOUT EXCEPTION**. The Ecuadorian Judo Federation will not assume any responsibility for the availability of accommodation and meals in case of non-compliance with the registration and reservation deadlines.

THE COUNTRIES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE EXPENSES DERIVED BY THE BANK TRANSACTION, THUS THE PAYMENTS MADE BY BANK TRANSFER WILL HAVE AN ADDED COST OF 5% OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT.

IMPORTANT: All damages to the property of the hotel or places of the tournament that result from the stay of the delegation, must be assumed by the respective National Federation, which will pay for all damages that have occurred. 11. COMPETITION REGULATIONS

The competition will be conducted according to the IJF's refereeing regulations.
Repechage will be of quarter-final.

- Weight In will be every night before competition
- All judocas, **NO EXCEPTIONS, must present ACCREDITATION AND PASSPORT.**

13. D R A W

- The draw will be on Friday 14 of June at 16h00 in Hotel
- Every National Federation can be represented with a max of 2 oficals and they must be accredited.
- Dreasing code: suit and tie.



14. COACHES

- The code of behavior of the coaches will be observed strictly, including the dress code, which for this event may be with jacket, pants and tie or the sports uniform of your delegation.
- Coaches are not allowed to give directions to competitors while they are fighting. Only during MATE breaks are coaches allowed to give instructions to their athletes. After the break and the continuation of the match, the coaches must remain silent again.
- If a coach does not respect these rules, he can be expelled from the competition area. If a coach persists in his behavior from outside the competition area, he may be penalized and expelled from the sports arena.



15. TRAINING SESSION

The training schedule should be requested by the Head of Delegation at the time of accreditation.



16. JUDOGI CONTROL

The control of the measures of the judogi will be done according to the current regulations of the IJF.



17. BACKNUMBER

- Each participant has the obligation to have sewn on the back of the judogui, the backnumber with his surname and the abbreviation of the country. It must have the following dimension:
Width 38 cm - Height 39 cm.
- The Backnumber should be fixed horizontally and centered on the back of the judogui. It should be 3 cm below the bottom of the flap. The backnumber can get it on the site:
www.ijfbacknumber.com
- The backnumber are the responsibility of each Federation. Failure to comply with this requirement will mean the disqualification of the judoka from the competition.



18. FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPALS

All National Teams, delegates, coaches and athletes, who participate in the event, must respect and accept the authority of the officials appointed by the organizers, the rules of organization, and the Arbitration Rules of the IJF.



19. AWARDING CEREMONY

- All the medal ceremony athletes must ser WHITE judogi.
- Each athlete who has won a medal must present at the ceremony to receive their medal personally. Any athlete who is absent in the awarding ceremony without a good Reason may forfeit the medal.
- It is strictly forbidden for athletes on the podium to have national flags or similar items
- Any demonstration with relegious, political, personal or commercial connotation is prohibited. It is also forbidden to attend the medal ceremony wearing caps or any similiar head covering.
