Accommodation & meals:

Organizers provide free accommodation in the Campus of the Far Eastern Federal University (island Russkiy) with full board for teams (16 judokas and 5 officials) during tournament (3rd – 6th September, 3 nights). 5th of September lunch will be provide at “Fetisov Arena”.

Tournament will be held in three team disciplines:

1. Team men
2. Team women
3. Mixed team

According to the results of performance in each discipline, the winner, second, third, fourth and fifth place will be determined.

Further, the results from all three disciplines are summarized and the absolute winner is determined, the 2nd and 3rd place of the tournament.

Competition system:

Team men – Round-robin

Team women – Round-robin

Mixed team – Round-robin with final, winners in groups go straight to final, second places fight for bronze.

Awards are held in all three disciplines and in the overall standings.

Weight categories for men team competitions:

Boys: 50 kg, 55 kg, 66 kg, 73 kg, 90 kg

Weight categories for women team competition:

Women: 40 kg, 44 kg, 52 kg, 57 kg, 70 kg

Weight categories of mixed team competitions:

Men: 60 kg, 81 kg, 81+ kg

Women: 48 kg, 63 kg, 63+ kg

Scoring:

1st place – (team men, team women, mixed team) – 100 points

2nd place – (team men, team women, mixed team) – 70 points

3rd place – (team men, team women, mixed team) – 50 points

4th place – (team men, team women, mixed team) – 30 points

5th place – (team men, team women, mixed team) – 10 points

Weigh-in:

Athletes must present accreditation card and his/her passport (National ID Card showing nationality and date of birth are also accepted)

Competition rules:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules on 2 mats.

Tournament mode:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules.

Judogi:

All Judoka must compete in IJF approved judogi.

Back numbers:

Each competitor taking part in the event is obliged to have sewn on the back of his Judogi the official back number (IJF are allowed) bearing his surname and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation. The back number can be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com or www.ijfbacknumber.com (Attention: production and delivery may take around 4 weeks). The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.

Awarding:

All medal winners will be awarded with medals. All teams medals winners will be awarded with trophies.

The best judokas (1 male and 1 female) of the tournament will be awarded by the special prize from Yasuhiro Yamashita, Olympic champion, fourfold world champion, nine fold champion of Japan.

Training:

Tatami for training will be available on September 3th and September 4th from 8:00 till 20:00. Sport hall is located in the Campus of the Far Eastern Federal University (building S2)
