



## **Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games Tripartite Commission Invitation Places (Wild card invitation places)**

Judo receives 20 Invitation Places.

The National Olympic Committees (NOCs), not the National Federation, **MUST** make an Invitation Place application to the International Olympic Committee (IOC) **NOT** to the IJF.

The **DEADLINE** for NOCs to make the application is **2 October 2019 - 17 January 2020**.

Invitation Places can only be allocated to NOCs with an average of eight (8) or less athletes in individual sports/disciplines at the last two editions of the Olympic Games (London 2012 and Rio 2016) so **ONLY** the following 92 NOCs can apply.

The IOC Commission will review all applications received from eligible NOCs and the final allocation of Invitation Places will be made after **31 May 2020**.

The NOC must confirm immediately if they will accept the invitation place.
