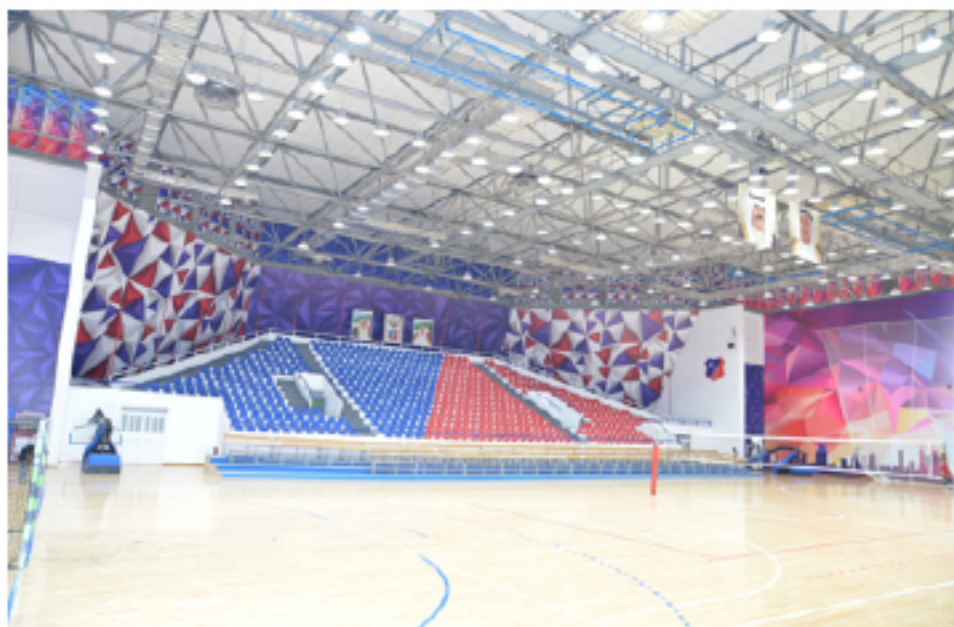

Eligibility

Each IJF and/or JUA member federations can register maximum 2 clubs with one men team and/or one women team to take part in the 2019 Asian Club Judo Tournament, and no limit of entries for Junior Individual competitions.

Age limit: 15 years old or above and under 21 years old (calendar year), (must be born between 1999 and 2004)

Reminders: For contestants under 18 year old, the secondary entry must be countersigned by parent / guardian.

Division

Junior men: -60 kg, -66 kg, -73 kg, -81 kg, -90 kg, -100 kg, +100 kg
Junior women: -48 kg, -52 kg, -57 kg, -63 kg, -70 kg, -78 kg, +78 kg

Junior Men team competition: According to the IJF and JUA SOR, for men team competition, each team will consist of 5 (five) competitors and the weight categories should be as follows:
-66 kg, -73 kg, -81 kg, -90 kg, +90 kg

Junior Women team competition: According to the IJF and JUA SOR, for women team competition, each team will consist of 5 (five) competitors and the weight categories should be as follows:
-52 kg, -57 kg, -63 kg, -70 kg, +70 kg

Participation

Besides of unlimited number of individual entries,

Each IJF/JUA member federation can entry: Max **4** club teams (2 men teams and/or 2 women teams)

Host country can entry:

Max **8** club teams (4 men teams and/or 4 women teams)

Foreign athletes

There is a maximum quota of 2 (two) foreign athletes allowed in a team for each team contest. In case the team is represented in a team contest by a total of 4 athletes or 3 athletes, the quota is one (1) foreign athlete allowed in a team. The team contest will be held from the lightest to the heaviest weight category.

The competitors will be entered at the category they belong to. However, they can compete in the category immediately above their own category.

Line up to the teams

Before each team contest the team leader must present to the Sport Director the line-up of the team. At each round he/she has the right to replace one or several competitors by other competitors of the corresponding weight category or from the next lower category. All competitors in the line-up for the team entering the mat for the official bow have to compete. If one competitor does not compete the team will lose by disqualification 0 - 5! A competitor, who has presented himself for the contest and does not compete, loses the right to compete in the event. If one team does not arrive for the match, the other team will be declared the winner 5 - 0.

Decision

The men and women team contest consists of 5 individual contests in the 5 weight categories respectively men (-66 kg, -73 kg, -81 kg, -90 kg, +90 kg) and women (-52 kg, -57 kg, -63 kg, -70 kg, +70 kg) categories. In case of an equal score at the end of an individual contest, the contest will be continued with Golden Score. The number of individual contests won will decide the winning team.

In case the both teams are represented by 4 athletes only and the number of wins is equal, the team with the higher sum of winning technical scores is the winner. In case the sum of winning technical scores is also equal, there will be a draw of one weight category for a decisive contest under direct Golden Score rule.

Referees

Per club can have one (1) accompanied referee with continental or IJF referee license, the host country can have two (2) per club. The meeting of the referees will be held immediate after draw for all referees, the attendance at the referee meeting is strictly compulsory.

Dress code: Jacket suit with tie.

Responsibility of Clubs/Federations

The competitors will compete under the full responsibility of their federations. Each national federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against "injury and third party risk (public liability)" during the period of the tournament. The Judo Union of Asia and the organizer decline all responsibility.

Insurance

Each National Federation will assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liability for their contestants and officials. The JUA and the Organizing Committee will not be responsible for any claims of illness, injury and death, of any participants/officials whatsoever. Nevertheless the National

Visa

1. The local organiser will provide a letter of support for visa applications if required. To request a letter of support, please provide a copy of the persons passport. Visa support letters will only be provided for people who are inscribed for the event or event officials.

Doping Control

Doping control will be carried out in accordance with ASADA guidelines, the IJF Anti- doping Rules and the IJF SOR during the competition after the final block.

This may include the winner of the category and one of the three other medal winners by draw.
