4. TRANSPORT



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The organizer will provide transportation for competing delegations during the competition. This transportation service (including airport transfers, to / from accreditation, training, draw and sport hall) is only offered on the days when the delegations are booked in an official hotel through the organizers. On days delegations are using an unofficial hotel or an official hotel, not reserved through the organizers, they are not allowed to use the official event transportation.

If the delegation misses the transport deadline the organizers are not obliged to provide airport transfers. Transfers for this event will be arranged from/to:

6. INSURANCE

Each National Federation is responsible for its competitors (the control of non-pregnancy and the control of gender). It must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as civil liabilities during the events for everyone under their charge.

The organizer of the event and the IJF will not be responsible for any insurance related to the above-mentioned matters. Nevertheless, the National Judo Federation staging the event shall take all necessary actions to provide insurance coverage against civil liability for the entire duration. The organizer of the event and the IJF have no liability for any claims of injury, illness or death arising from the travelling to and the participation in this event.

8. PARTICIPATION

All the participants must have valid IJF ID card, otherwise registration for this event is not possible. This JUA Cup Juniors is open for all JUA/IJF Member Federations. There is no limit in the number of participation for each weight category for every federation.

The competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which enters them. In case a Federation or a club registers an athlete with a different Nationality, a confirmation letter from the National Federation of the country of which the athlete holds the passport should be presented during the accreditation.

9. COMPETITION RULES

Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JUA Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF Refereeing Rules.

The "Golden score" with no time limit. Referee's decision is cancelled.

10. REFEREES

Each participating countries may enter TWO (2) referees at maximum. Referees must have IJF International or Continental Referee License.

11. WEIGH-IN

Weigh-in will be conducted one evening prior the event.

Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear and a T-shirt. Additional 100g will be allowed for their weight category limits. Athletes must present accreditation card, IJF ID card and his/her passport (National ID Card showing nationality and date of birth are also accepted).

12. DRAW

The draw will take place at the office of the Judo Fedeartion of Uzbekistan at 05:00 p.m. on April 08, 2020.

Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the Draw, a maximum of two (2) delegates per National Federation (2 officials) will be authorized.

13. JUDOGI

Approved Judogi

Athletes must compete wearing an IJF approved judogi supplied by one of the following manufacturers: Taishan, Double D Adidas, BasicItalia (Kappa), Budo Sport AG (Hiku), Danrho Kwon KG, Daedo, Essimo, Fighting Films, Green Hill, Kusakura (Hayakawa), Ipponshop, Mizuno, Matsuru B.V, SFJAM Noris, Toyo Martial Arts and Yawara.

Judogi Control

It will be operated with a Sokuteiki prior to the fight. Judogi must have an IJF Official Label "APPROVED JUDOGI" with an optical code which cannot be falsified. The label can be controlled

with an optical lamp. Each of the competition clothing articles (jacket, trousers and belt) must have an IJF official label.

Backnumber

For further information on judogi rules please refer to the IJF SOR. Each competitor is obliged to have sewn on the back of his judogi a backnumber bearing their last (family) name and National Olympic Committee abbreviation. The last (family) name (and any part of their given (first) name) on the back number must have the same letters as that registered in judobase.org as this database provides the accreditation cards, athlete name on TV graphics and scoreboard etc.

National Emblem

Athletes can have their national emblem on the left front part of the jacket within a space of 100cm2.



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14. COACHING

Coaches nominated by their National Federations should respect the IJF Code of Ethics and IJF SOR. Any coaches not adhering to these rules could be subject to disciplinary action.

1st Place – Gold Medal with Diploma

2nd Place – Silver Medal with Diploma

3rd Place – Bronze Medal with Diploma

The Ministry of Physical Culture and Sport of the Republic of Uzbekistan will provide foreign teams with printed products and memorable products with the logo of the Judo Federation of Uzbekistan (circle, package, poster, pen, diplomas, etc.)

16. VISA
