IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC (ENG) ANYONE NOT FOLLOWING THE IJF COVID-19 PROTOCOL WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE EVENT AND SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION!

The fundamental principle throughout all IJF/JUA events during the Covid-19 era is to protect and be protected by wearing a mask, sanitizing, distancing, and respecting the recommendations of the IJF protocol. All participants have the mutual responsibility to protect one another. Each National Federation delegation participant (athlete, coach, team official, physiotherapist, doctor, President, etc.) must have read and understood the latest version of the Protocol for resuming IJF events during the Covid-19 pandemic which can be found here: **covid.ijf.org**

Before travelling

- 1. Check if you need a visa and if yes request it from the organizer.
- 2. Book accommodation and send a detailed rooming list. Last-minute changes can be accommodated whilst the delegation waits on the bus or outside the hotel.
- 3. Request **an Exceptional Entry Permit** from the organizer. All participants should write to the organizer (**kazakhstan.judo.fed@gmail.com**) to request the Exceptional Entry Permit. For each delegate send a good quality passport copy along with their arrival and departure dates.
- 4. Present on arrival, at least **two (2) Covid-19 negative** individual medical certificate. Please make sure the certificate also has an English version.

These PCR tests MUST be made no more than 72 hours before arrival.

- 5. Present upon arrival an individual **declaration of honor** and **liability release waiver** on the absence of symptoms for at least 14 days per delegate.
- 6. Upload just before arrival to **my.ijf.org** an individual **Liability Release Waiver** (Liab-Waiv) and **Declaration of Honour** (Dec-of-Hon) on the absence of symptoms for at least 14 days per delegate

PCR TEST

- 1. Present, on arrival, at least two (2) negative individual medical PCR COVID-19 test certificates (PCR-1 and PCR-2). Please make sure the certificate also has an English version. These PCR tests MUST be made a maximum of five (5) days before arrival and taken a minimum of 48 hours apart. If travelling by plane, please CHECK WITH THE AIRLINE that the date and time of the second PCR follows the airline's "safe to fly" rule timeline (Note: currently for arrival in Kazakhstan this is a maximum of 72 hours before arrival). During this 5-day period you should stay isolated and limit contact with other people as much as possible. If you experience any kind of symptoms do not start to travel (even with two negative PCR tests).
- 2. PCR-3 test will be performed immediately upon arrival.
 - (Until test results are obtained, all participants must remain in their hotel rooms)
- 3. Exit tests may be booked with the **COVID-19 Manager**, if required. Price is 40\$

Throughout your stay

- 1. Wash/sanitize your hands regularly, especially if you have had contact with a person or an object. Competitors should wash and disinfect their hands and feet regularly, especially before the warm-up and the contest.
- 2. No handshake greet each other with a bow.
- 3. Wear a mask at all times (change it at least twice a day). Exceptions: masks are not obligatory on the Field of Play tatami, on the warm-up tatami whilst warming up, or on the training tatami whilst training. Masks may be removed while eating in dining areas.
- 4. Maintain 1.5 m distance at all times, except for competitors during training, their contests and during warming up with **ONE PARTNER**.
- 5. Submit yourselves to contactless temperature measurement by the organizer on arrival at the point of entry in the country, at accommodation premises, throughout the competition venue and at any official venue of the event, to be accepted by all accredited populations.

Anyone who experiences symptoms after arrival must immediately contact their Team COVID-19 Manager who should then contact the IJF COVID-19 Manager:

In case of a positive test result we will follow the Kazakhstan Federation Government/Ministry of Health procedure.

In case of a positive result of the PCR test, quarantine measures by the decree of the chief sanitary doctor of city Almaty and the sanitary-epidemiological standards of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

Anyone with a positive test MUST stay in the quarantine hotel provided by the LOC. The cost must be paid by the National Federation

If a positive person takes another test during the quarantine period:

If positive:	Quarantine period continues until negative
If negative:	Quarantine must be finished
When the quaratine period is over:	To leave Kazakhstan a negative tests is needed

Close contacts will also be traced and may be isolated/quarantined depending on the LOC Ministry of Health procedure. Please note their definition of close contact may differ from that described in the IJF protocol.

Insurance

It is the responsibility of the National Federation to ensure that in addition to their normal insurance they have sufficient insurance in place to cover any COVID-19-related costs. The LOC of the event and the IJF accept no liability for any claims relating to cancellation of the event due to COVID-19 or medical costs for any COVID-19 related illness that may affect a National Federation delegation member during the event.

LIABILITY RELEASE WAIVER

The World Health Organization has declared the novel Corona virus (COVID-19) a world wide pandemic. Due to its capacity to transmit from person-to-person through respiratory droplets, the IJF has set recommendations, guidelines, and some prohibitions throughout the **Protocol for resuming IJF events during the COVID-19 pandemic (IJF COVID-19 Protocol)**. The IJF COVID-19 Protocol applies to all the IJF/JUA events' participants.

In consideration of my participation in the IJF/JUA events, I, the undersigned:

- **1.** Confirm that I have taken good note of the IJF COVID Protocol and hereby undertake comply with it.
- **2.** Acknowledge and agree to the following:
- I am aware of the existence of the risk on my physical appearance to the venue and my participation to the IJF/JUA events that may cause injury or illness such as, COVID-19.
- I have not experienced symptoms that of fever, fatigue, difficulty in breathing, or dry cough or exhibiting any other symptoms relating to COVID-19 or any communicable disease within the last 14 days.

- 8.3. Kazakhstan Judo Federation does not provide free air travel.

9. Awarding

9.1. Winners and medalists will be awarded certificates and medals.

10. Entries and Visa

For nations who need VISA to enter Kazakhstan, please send the "Visa Application Form" fully filled not later than April 26, 2021.

- -Kazakhstan Judo Federation pays visa support expenses for the team members as (athletes, coaches, judges, representatives)
- All the team members are responsible for their visa expenses.

Official confirmation of participation in the competition with an indication of the number of members of the sports delegation should be provided 15 days before the tournament starts at the address: 010000, The Republic of Kazakhstan, Astana city, Turan av. 18, office 205, e-mail: Kazakhstan.judo.fed@gmail.com. Final entries in the prescribed form should be applied on arrival day (passport or identity card is mandatory).

11. Obligatory and additional conditions of admittance

- 11.1.Foreign teams upon accreditation shall provide the following document:
 - original application of names certified by national or regional Judo Federation;
 - original passports of each participant.
- 11.2.Each team participating in competition shall provide a referee (judge with personal invitation cannot be a team member).
- 11.3. Teams not provided second (preliminary, of names) application can't be admitted for accreditation.

11.4.Kimono

- Participants of competitions shall have two kimonos (blue and white) according to the international standard.
- Kimono control shall be carried out with sokuteki.
- All athletes participating in the competition shall have attached to kimono official back number.

12. Responsibility of participants

- 12.1. Sending organizations undertake responsibility for participants relating to:
 - The level of their sport performance, permit of doctor;
 - Medical insurance for the period of participation.
- 12.2.Organizers undertake no responsibility for loss, theft of damage of personal property of participants.

13. Doping Control

Doping control will include: **four (4)** men and **four (4)** women.

Competitors must report to the Doping Control Station immediately after signing the notification form.

Pursuant to **WADA ISTI Art. 5.4.4**, prior to doping control, athletes can take part in the awarding ceremony and fulfill their press commitments or receive medical treatment if needed.

The selected competitors will be constantly accompanied by an official chaperone (appointed by the organising committee) from the time of notification until arriving at the Doping Control Station. A person of the athletes' choice (team doctor, coach, trainer, delegation head etc.) may accompany them. IJF keep the right to test any participating athlete beyond the above selection during an event.

All additional tests are deemed in-competition tests. At its own discretion IJF may allow Testing Authorities to conduct out out-of-competition tests as well.

14. Insurance

Each National Federation is directly responsible for its athletes (the control of non-pregnancy and the control of gender).

It must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as civil liabilities during all IJF events for everyone under their charge.

National Federations are responsible to provide insurance guarantees to their delegates during any IJFWJT event. The organiser of the event and the IJF will not be responsible in the absence of insurance. The entity contractually bound to the IJF for the organisation of the event shall take all necessary actions to provide insurance coverage against civil liability for the entire duration.

The LOC of the event and the IJF have no liability for any claims of injury, illness or death arising from the travelling to and the participation in this event.
