## IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

**ANYONE NOT FOLLOWING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND IJF COVID-19 PROTOCOLS WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE EVENT AND SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION!**

The fundamental principle throughout all IJF events during the Covid-19 era is to Protect and Be Protected by wearing a mask, sanitising, distancing and respecting the recommendations of "**the Protocol for resuming IJF events during the Covid-19 pandemic**" hereafter referred to as IJF COVID-19 Protocol. All participants have the mutual responsibility to protect each other.

Each National Federation delegation participant (athlete, coach, team official, physiotherapist, doctor President etc.) and media representatives must have read and understood the latest version of the IJF COVID-19 Protocol which can be found here: [covid.ijf.org](https://www.ijf.org/covid)

### Before travelling

1. Passports must be valid for **at least 6 month** from the date of arrival. Check if you need a **visa**, and if yes, request it from the LOC according to details in the visa section.
2. Get an **entry permission letter** for entry to Hungary from the Hungarian Judo Association.
3. Send **travel** information (arrival and departures) to [covid@ijf.org](mailto:covid@ijf.org)
4. Book **accommodation** and send a detailed rooming list.
5. Send in advance to [covid@ijf.org](mailto:covid@ijf.org) and present, on arrival, at least **two (2) negative individual medical PCR COVID-19 test certificates** (PCR-1 and PCR-2). The Hungarian Government requires all arriving participants of World Championships to obtain and present on arrival to Hungary two (2) negative COVID-19 PCR test certificates in Hungarian or in English language. The tests are required to be made a maximum of **five (5) days** before arrival and 48 hours apart. During this 5-day period you should stay isolated and limit contact with other people as much as possible. If you experience any kind of symptoms do not start to travel (even with two negative PCR tests). Airlines may require you to show this on check-in and some airlines require the certificate to be no more than 72 hours before arrival in your destination (please check with your airline).
6. Send to [covid@ijf.org](mailto:covid@ijf.org) an individual **Liability Release Waiver** (Liab-Waiv) and **Declaration of Honour** (Dec-of-Hon) which can be found in the documents section: <https://www.ijf.org/competition/2239>

### Entering Budapest

1. All border-crossing regulations must be followed regarding the validity of passports and visas, as applicable for each respective country.
2. All the participants must have a printed copy of the invitation letter from the Hungarian Judo Association.
3. According to the Government Decree 408/2020 (30 August) on travel restrictions during the period of state of epidemiological preparedness, entering Hungary it is necessary to show up two (2) negative COVID-19 PCR test results in Hungarian or in English language. The tests are required to be made a maximum of **five (5) days** before arrival and 48 hours apart.

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## Entering the bubble

From arrival in Budapest you must immediately go to the official hotel. After your activity is finished you must leave Budapest without visiting any friends, shops, restaurants etc.

The event venues (hotels, sport hall, training hall etc.) will be classified as bubbles and to reduce risk a “bubble to bubble” concept will be used. **People are NOT allowed to leave their bubble** as contamination could occur endangering the safety of the event and the health of the participants.

The World Judo Championships Hungary 2021 hotel **bubble opens** from: **31 May 2021**. If due to flight schedules you need to arrive earlier, contact the Local Organising Committee (LOC) and they will assist you with a solution.

1. **PCR-3 test** will be performed immediately upon arrival.

<b>Collection place:</b>	Centralised test station in a tent at the parking lot at Hotel Arena.
<b>Test collection times:</b>	08:00-20:00 In case of early or late arrival there will be testing personnel available.
<b>Results issued within:</b>	max. 24 hours
<b>Extra requirements:</b>	PCR test: 4 hours before taking the test do not eat, do not drink, do not brush teeth, do not use mouth wash or nasal spray, do not smoke, do not have chewing gums or candies

Until test results are obtained, all participants **must remain in their hotel rooms**, where water and any paid meals will be ensured until the receipt of the test results.

Following PCR-3 there will be a rapid antigen test every three (3) days.

## Throughout your stay

1. Wash/sanitise your hands regularly, especially if you have had contact with a person or an object. Competitors should wash and disinfect their hands and feet regularly, especially before the warm-up and the contest.
2. No handshake - greet each other with a bow.
3. Wear a mask at all times (change it at least twice a day). Exceptions: masks are not obligatory on the Field of Play tatami, on the warm-up tatami whilst warming up or on the training tatami whilst training. Masks must be worn in dining areas at all times, except when sitting eating.
4. Maintain **1.5m distance** at all times, except for competitors during training, their contests and during warming up with **ONE PARTNER**.
5. Submit yourselves to contactless temperature measurement by the organiser on arrival at the point of entry in the country, at accommodation premises, throughout the competition venue and at any official venue of the event, to be accepted by all accredited population. Anyone registering a high temperature will be asked to remain outside and the LOC COVID-19 Manager and the IJF COVID-19 Manager will be contacted. An opportunity to recheck their temperature will be given, if it is still high a final decision will be made by the LOC COVID-19 Manager and the IJF COVID-19 Manager.

6. Close contact – a close contact (for the purpose of isolation/quarantine) is considered as a person who is/was:
- Sharing the same hotel room.
  - Had face-to-face contact at a distance of less than two meters for more than 15 minutes (i.e. training or warm-up partner).
  - Seated together in an aircraft or other means of transport without wearing a mask.

Hungarian Government definition of close contact is more strict and will be followed:

- A person who was seated less than two seats in every direction from an infected person in an aircraft.
- Each person travelling together with an infected person in a car, or who was seated less than two seats in a minibus (up to 18 seats) or in a bus (up to 50 seats).

**In case of a positive test result we will follow the Hungarian Government/Ministry of Health procedure.**

<b>Quarantine period:</b>	Minimum 10 days
<b>Quarantine hotel:</b>	Danubius Hotel Helia

<b>Rates (per person per night, full board):</b>	215 euro

Anyone with a positive test MUST stay in the quarantine hotel provided by the LOC. The cost must be paid by the company who the media representative belongs to.

If a positive person takes another test during the quarantine period:

<b>If positive:</b>	Quarantine period must be completed.
<b>If negative:</b>	Quarantine period must be completed.
<b>When the quarantine period is over:</b>	The quarantine is over and the person does not have any symptoms, person can leave the country without any further tests.

Close contacts will also be traced and may be isolated/quarantined depending on the LOC National Public Health Center of Hungary procedure. Please note their definition of close contact may differ from that described in the IJF protocol.

### Insurance

It is the responsibility of the international media representative to ensure that in addition to their normal insurance they have sufficient insurance in place to cover any COVID-19-related costs. The LOC of the event and the IJF accept no liability for any claims relating to cancellation of the event due to COVID-19 or medical costs.

### Symptoms after arrival

Anyone who experiences symptoms after arrival must immediately contact the LOC COVID-19 Manager

**Access will be given by e-mail.**

All international media representatives, who inscribe for an IJF WJT event, must reserve their accommodation in one of the official hotels published in the event outlines. The reservation must be made with the LOC (not directly with the hotel).

Due to the COVID-19 situation, ALL participants MUST stay at the official hotel for the ENTIRE PERIOD of their stay, as the bubble-to-bubble concept is used at this event.

Any damage to hotel property resulting from the stay of an international media representative will be charged to the National Federation and must be paid in full.

According to the IJF rule enacted on the 2 December 2012 in Tokyo, "the organising country should not request penalties fee for participating countries who cannot make bank transfers but can pay in cash upon arrival. Those countries who cannot make bank transfers should inform the organisers well in advance that they will pay cash on arrival".

Note: The LOC will do their best to provide your first choice of accommodation but, as rooms might be limited, this cannot be guaranteed. After the accommodation deadline, the organiser cannot promise rooms in the hotels detailed in these outlines and another official hotel may be added.

Full board includes breakfast, lunch\* and dinner at the hotel.

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If payment is being made by bank transfer the bank information must be inserted correctly and completely on the transfer document and any procedures related to amendment of the bank transfer must be done before arrival. Media representatives must ensure that all bank charges are paid at their end so that the organisers receive the correct amount of funds without any deductions. Media representatives must have proof of the bank transfer, upon arrival.

## 9. GENERAL INFORMATION

### FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES

All National Federations, officials, coaches and athletes participating in the event described in these outlines must respect and accept the authority of the IJF Officials, the IJF Statutes, the IJF Sports and Organisation Rules (SOR), the IJF Refereeing Rules and the IJF Anti-Doping Rules. Individuals deemed to have acted against the IJF, its principles or purposes should be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation cards.

### INSURANCE

Everyone is responsible for their own insurance and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as civil liabilities during any IJF WJT event.

The organiser of the event and the IJF will not be responsible in the absence of insurance.

The entity contractually bound to the IJF for the organisation of the event shall take all necessary actions to provide insurance coverage against civil liability for the entire duration.

The LOC of the event and the IJF have no liability for any claims of injury, illness or death arising from the travelling to and the participation in this event.

### ACCREDITATION

The purpose of accreditation is to identify people and their roles at events and allow them necessary access to perform their roles.

Accreditation cards may be picked up from the accreditation centre, from the welcome desk at the hotel after the draw, from the media entrance welcome desk in the sport hall, or from any other place dedicated to media which will be indicated.

An accredited person should never wear another person's accreditation card. The accreditation card remains the property of the IJF and can be withdrawn, with immediate effect, at the IJF's sole discretion.

The accreditation card is valid for the duration of the competition and is the personal identity document of the delegate for all security and access controls. This card contains: last (family) name, first (given) name, country, IJF ID number, media status (writer, photographer) and a picture. Replacement of lost or forgotten accreditation will be charged at 50 US\$ to be paid to the IJF.



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## RESPECT TOWARDS ATHLETES

Throughout the event, from arrival to departure, media representatives must observe strict respect for the athletes and their delegation. No access to the training areas set up in the hotels will be authorized, as well as to the warm-up area at the competition venue. The delegations need calm to prepare and concentrate, the international media will only have access to the athletes under the conditions of the competition, at the stadium, in a mixed zone, in compliance with the Covid protocol.
