# IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC ANYONE NOT FOLLOWING THE IJF COVID-19 PROTOCOL WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE EVENT AND SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

The fundamental principle throughout all IJF/JUA events during the Covid-19 era is to protect and be protected by wearing a mask, sanitizing, distancing and respecting the recommendations of the IJF protocol. All participants have the mutual responsibility to protect one-another.

Each National Federation delegation participant (athlete, coach, team official, physiotherapist, doctor, President etc.) must have read and understood the latest version of the Protocol for resuming IJF events during the Covid-19 pandemic which can be found here: covid.ijf.org

#### **Before travelling**

- 1. Passports must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of arrival. Check if you need a visa, and if yes request it from the organizer.
- 2. Book accommodation and send a detailed rooming list. Last minute changes can be accommodated whilst the delegation waits on the bus or outside the hotel.
- 3. VISA: In order to ensure the smooth issuance of visas, all the Delegates should send e-mail the Visa application Form (attached), and a good quality copies of passports to the Judo Association of Thailand, through Email: <a href="https://hassabodin@hotmail.com">hassabodin@hotmail.com</a>, <a href="judo.thailand@yahoo.com">judo.thailand@yahoo.com</a> not later than 15th June 2022.
- 4. Present upon arrival an individual declaration of honor and liability release waiver on the absence of symptoms for at least 14 days per delegate.
- 5. Entry to Thailand by Air travel, please see the details for **Entry Measures into Thailand by Air travel** (Announced by Department Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs) as below the details;





#### Important:

Entry Measures into Thailand by Air travel >>

From 1 May 2022, travelers entering Thailand by air will be subject to new entry measures, as follows;

#### 1. Fully Vaccinated Persons must:

- Register on Thailand Pass (https://tp.consular.go.th)
- Attach required documents including passport, certificate of vaccination
- Attach proof of insurance with at least 10,000 USD coverage for medical treatments in Thailand (for non-Thais only)

(COVID-19 test, both prior to and after arriving in Thailand, is no longer required)

#### 2. Unvaccinated / Not Fully Vaccinated Persons

- **2.1** (**Option 1 Exemption from quarantine**) Travelers with a negative RT-PCR test result issued within 72 hours before traveling must:
- Register on Thailand Pass (<u>https://tp.consular.go.th</u>)
- Attach required documents including passport, and COVID-19 RT-PCR test result issued within 72 hours before traveling (must attach on Thailand Pass only)
- Attach proof of insurance with at least 10,000 USD coverage for medical treatments in Thailand (for non-Thais only)

(Any COVID-19 test after arriving in Thailand is not required)

PLEASE NOTE Travelers who have been approved to enter Thailand under AQ scheme but wish to enter Thailand under exemption from quarantine must re-apply on Thailand Pass.

- **2.2** (**Option 2 Quarantine**) Travelers who cannot undergo an RT-PCR test result within 72 hours before traveling or wish to be quarantined must:
- Register on Thailand Pass
- Attach required documents including passport, Alternative Quarantine (AQ) hotel confirmation for 5 days (including 1 RT-PCR test)
- Attach proof of insurance with at least 10,000 USD coverage for medical treatments in Thailand (for non-Thais only)
- undergo an RT-PCR test on Day 4 5 in Thailand during the mandatory 5-day quarantine at AO hotel

PLEASE NOTE Travelers whose Thailand Pass have already been issued can travel with the issued QR Code and do not need to register for new Thailand Pass.

#### Mixed Vaccination

Thailand fully recognizes mixed vaccination. The second dose needs to be administered based on the recommended timeframe for each vaccine type (first dose)

#### 2nd dose after 2 weeks 1st dose Sinovac

#### 2nd dose after 3 weeks

- 1st dose Pfizer-BioNTech
  - Sinopharm
  - Sputnik V
  - Novavax / Covovax

#### 2nd dose after 4 weeks

- 1st dose AstraZeneca
  - Moderna
  - Covaxin
  - Medigen

- **REMARK** To be considered fully vaccinated, your 2nd dose must be administered at least 14 days before your travel
  - Those vaccinated with the 1st dose of Janssen (Johnson&Johnson) vaccine are considered fully vaccinated

#### **Entering the bubble**

The event venues (hotels, sport hall, training hall etc.) will be classified as bubbles and to reduce risk a "bubble to bubble" concept will be used. People are NOT allowed to leave their bubble as contamination could occur endangering the safety of the event and the health of the participants.

#### PCR TEST ON ARRIVAL:

At least one (1) PCR test per participant will be performed immediately upon arrival. All participants must take a PCR immediately upon arrival. The test will be held at the **Piyavate Hospital by Drive Thru COVID-19 Test** before going to official hotel:

#### **ANTIGEN TEST:**

Antigen test for athletes will be taken before their weigh-in with the results delivered before the official weigh-in.

#### **EXIT TESTS**

Exit tests, if required, may be booked with the organizer, if required.

#### **COVID-19 REGULATIONS**

One PCR-tests will take from athletes in Bangkok - before arrival in the hotel and one Antigen-Test before weigh-in, which will cost 80 USD in total. The officials will be one PCR testedbefore arrival in the hotel, which will cost 80 USD in total. For Exit tests, if required which will cost 160 USD in total (Exit Tests included). The cost must be paid by the National Federation.

#### Throughout your stay

- 1. Wash/sanitise your hands regularly, especially if you have had contact with a person or an object. Competitors should wash and disinfect their hands and feet regularly, especially before the warm-up and the contest.
- 2. No handshake greet each other with a bow.
- 3.. Wear a mask at all times (change it at least twice a day). Exceptions: masks are not obligatory on the Field of Play tatami, on the warm-up tatami whilst warming up or on the training tatami whilst training. Masks may be removed while eating in dining areas.
- 4. Maintain 1.5 m distance at all times, except for competitors during training, their contests and during warming up with ONE PARTNER.
- 5. Submit yourselves to contactless temperature measurement by the organizer on arrival at the point of entry in the country, at accommodation premises, throughout the competition venue and at any official venue of the event, to be accepted by all accredited population.

Anyone registering a high temperature will be asked to remain outside and their Delegation COVID- 19 Manager, the LOC COVID-19 Manager and the JUA COVID-19 Manager will be contacted. An opportunity to recheck their temperature will be given, if it is still high a final decision will be made by the LOC COVID-19 Manager and the JUA COVID-19 Manager.

#### In case of a positive test result Full procedure is on covid.ijf.org

Anyone with a positive test have to go through the medical treatment process (by Piyavate Hospital) as prescribed by the Thai government rules. The cost must be paid by the National Federation. Please provide insurance with at least 10,000 USD coverage for medical treatments in Thailand (for non-Thais only).

#### If a positive person takes another test during the quarantine period:

If positive:	Quarantine must be finished
If negative:	Quarantine must be finished
When the quarantine period is over:	Only if Negative he/her can leave Thailand





#### Insurance:

It is the responsibility of the National Federation to ensure that in addition to their normal insurance they have sufficient insurance in place to cover any COVID-19-related costs. The organizer of the event and the JUA will not accept any liability or claims relating to cancellation of the event due to COVID-19 or medical costs for any COVID-19 related illness that may affect a National Federation delegation member during the event.

#### Recommended Medical Insurance:

While Staying in Thailand, your insurance must cover COVID-19-related cost as shown below:

- Medical expenses coverage of 10,000 USD minimum.
- Hospital isolation.
- Your insurance policy must be valid for the entire duration of your stay in Thailand.

According to the new IJF rule enacted on the December 2, 2012 in Tokyo country should not request fee penalties for countries which cannot make bank transfers but can pay in cash money upon arrival. On the other hand, they should inform well in advance the organizing country and specify the number of participants before the deadline".

Cancellation fees: up to 20 days before the hotel payment deadline, full refund. From 35 days before the arrival 50% of the payment. After **the 20**<sup>th</sup> **June, 2022** any cancellation of rooms reserved or no-show will result in 100% of the charge of the hotel costs that must be paid by the participating National Federation. Cancelations of the rooms cannot be made at the checkin. Injuries, visa problems or sickness are not valid reasons for cancellation of rooms.

**IMPORTANT**: All damages to property of hotels or venues resulting from the stay of a national delegation shall be charged to federation and paid in full.

#### Payment:

All fees will be paid in cash for the Judo Association of Thailand at the arrival.

Registration must be made through IJF Judobase registration system. Nations missing the registration will not be allowed to attend the event.

#### 8. WEIGH-IN:

- (a) The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the IJF & JUA SOR.
- (b) The athlete's official weigh in will be scheduled the day before the competition.

For Junior: Unofficial weigh-in: 17:30 to 18:00 (the day before)

Official weigh-in: 18:00 to 18:30 (the day before)

For Cadet: Unofficial weigh-in: 17:30 to 18:00 (the day before)

Official weigh-in: 18:00 to 18:30 (the day before)

- (c) 1st day weigh-in will be held in **Al Meroz Hotel Bangkok** and the other days weigh-in will be held in the **Indoor Stadium Huamark**
- (d) Random weigh-in will open one hour before the start of the competition each day until approximately 30 minutes before the athlete's first contest at the latest.

The athletes must bring their accreditation for identification. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5 % higher than the official maximum weight limit of the category.

**9. ELIGIBILITY**: The Member Federations / Associations of Judo Union of Asia. The athletes must be of the same nationality as the National Federation for which they have been entered for the competition.

- (a) Three participants from three different member federations must compete in a category in order that the championship for that category to be held.
- (b) In Cadets (men and women under 18) each National Federation may enter 10 entries in total for boys and 10 entries for girls. Only a maximum of two athletes per category for boys and the same for girls will be allowed. The total delegation of both men and women is a maximum of 20 athletes. There is no open category.
- (c) In Juniors (men and women under 21) each National Federation may enter 9 entries in total for men and 9 entries for women. Only a maximum of two athletes per category for men and the same for women will be allowed. The total delegation of both men and women is a maximum of 18 athletes. There is no open category.

#### **13. CONTESTANTS AGE:**

#### Cadet:

Men and Women under 18, age 15, 16 and 17 years (calendar year). (must be born between 2005, 2006, and 2007)

#### Junior:

Men and Women under 21, age 15 to 20 years (calendar year). (must be born between 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006 and 2007)

Reminders: For contestants under 18 years old, the entry form must be countersigned by parent / guardian.





#### 14. INSCRIPTION FEES

An inscription fee of US\$ 100 (hundred) per weight category has to be paid to the JUA General Treasurer: JUDO UNION OF ASIA, at the time of accreditation. As a last resort these fees can be paid at the Delegation Meeting for the championships. After the Delegation Meeting, under no condition refunds can be given.

#### 15. DRAW:

The draw will be held ONLINE on **Sunday, July 17th, 2022 at 14:30 at Al Meroz Hotel Bangkok** under the control of the JUA Sports Director.

Seeding: the top eight (8) from the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the current IJF Junior and Cadets World Ranking List.

#### 16. REFEREES:

Team Referee: Each delegation can enter TWO referees (all expenses are to be covered by each team) who must hold at least an IJF International or Continental Referee License.

#### 17. NATIONALITY:

Contestant must hold the same nationality of their Federation. Contestants are required to show his / her passport in order to confirm their nationality.

#### 18. JUDOGI & BACKNUMBER:

In accordance with the IJF and JUA regulations.

#### 19. INSURANCE:

Each National (Regional) Federation / Association will assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liability for their contestants and officials. The Judo Union of Asia, the Organizing Committee of Asian Cadet & Junior Judo Championships 2022, and Judo Association of Thailand will not be responsible of any claims of illness, injury, death and COVID-19 case of any participants/officials whatsoever.

#### **20. CEREMONIES:**

Contestants are required to attend the awarding ceremony in White Judogi with bare foot.

#### 21. ACCREDITATION:

The Accreditation will be held on 16th July to 17th July 2022, at Al Meroz Hotel Bangkok.





#### 22. LAND TRANSPORT:

The Organizing Committee will provide transport from the Bangkok International Airport to the Hotel upon arrival and from the Hotel to Bangkok International Airport on departure. During the Asian Cadet & Junior Judo Championships, transportation will be provided between the venue and hotel at predetermined times and schedules.

#### 23. PRIZES:

#### 24. METHODS OF COMPETITION:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules. Competition systems according to number of participants:

- 6 and more entries: Double repechage
- 3,4,5 entries: Round robin
- 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide

In order for an athlete to obtain points for the IJF Cadet and Junior Ranking List, her/his weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries.

#### 25. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL:

The Anti-Doping Control will be carried out in accordance with the IJF Anti-Doping Rules and JUA Sports Organization Rules.
