From 11 October 2022, nationals of Visa Exemption countries (see below the link) are no longer required to obtain a visa to enter Japan.

For nationals who need a visa to enter Japan

(countries not included in above the list of VISA Exemption),

please complete the Visa Form (Ver. 07-OCT) and submit along with clear passport copies to visatokyogs@judo.or.jp at your earliest convenience.

DEADLINE: 25 October 2022

- After receiving the visa request, we will issue the required documents from our side and e-mail them to you.
- Once the e-mail is received, please go to Embassy/Consulate for further the visa application.
- Please check in advance with your local Embassy / Consulate which documents you must prepare to obtain a visa (as they vary by each countries).

● JUDOBASE inscription

First of all, please register on the IJF judobase. Visa applications will only be accepted for people who are inscribed in the Tokyo GS 2022 event judobase.

● Place to apply for Visa

The place of visa application is basically at Embassy / Consular of your residence OR place of birth. If you wish to change the place of application, please consult with the Embassy / Consulate well in advance to confirm if it's possible.

Please make sure to indicate the place (country and city) of Japanese Embassy / Consulate where you intend to apply & receive VISA.
