# 3. Important Information

#### **Before Travelling**

Passports must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of arrival.

# 9. Responsibility of the Federations

The athletes will train under the full responsibility of their National Federations. Each National Federation is responsible for insuring its judoka against 'injury and third part risk (public liability)' during the period of the camp. The European Judo Union and Hungarian Judo Association decline all responsibility.

#### 10. Accreditation

At least one team delegate (and not more than 2) must attend the accreditation **on Tuesday, April 11<sup>th</sup> 2023 starting from 9:00 till 16:00 at Olympic Centre.** To confirm the entries of all athletes and officials and accommodation payment.

Very important: Each National Federation must be represented by a team leader or coach responsible for registration of ALL athletes from the respective National Federation, regardless club or other membership. Every National Federation will be accepted for accreditation only once, when all entries and payments can be confirmed at the same time.
