3. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Before Travelling,

- Passports must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of arrival.
- Check host country entry requirements and airline requirements (if applicable).
- Check if you need a visa, and if yes, request it from the LOC in accordance with the details in the ENTERING THE HOST COUNTRY section.
- Send travel information (arrival and departures) to the LOC.
- Book accommodation with the LOC.
- Upload a signed individual IJF Liability Release Waiver 2023 to my.ijf.org

Entering host country

Each individual is responsible to ensure they follow the entry rules (passport validity, visas, entry permission letter, protocol of COVID-19 etc.) of the host country. Entry rules may be subject to change, at present all specific Covid-Related rules to enter the country were lifted. Insurance

It is the responsibility of each participant to take out the insurance with general terms such as travel insurance, but also an additional insurance is required to bear the potential costs arising from COVID-19, including repatriation. Under no circumstances, the LOC of the event and the JUA accept no liability for any claims relating to cancellation of the event due to COVID-19 or medical costs for any COVID-19 related illness that may affect them during the event.

6. PARTICIPATION

This Asian Cup Cadets & Junior Hong Kong 2023 is open for all JUA/IJF Member Federations. There is no limit in the number of participants for each weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which enters them.

10. ACCREDITATION & CONTROL OF NATIONALITY

At least one team delegate (and not more than 2) must attend the accreditation/team list confirmation on 14th July 2023 (Friday) at the hotel from 10:00 – 13:00 on time in order to confirm the entries of all athletes and officials with his signature on the delegation confirmation list. A delayed appearance or no-show may result in the exclusion of all participants from the draw and the event. In case of unforeseen delay of arrival, the National Federation must immediately contact both the organiser and the JUA (chelucky@macau.ctm.net). Passports or photocopies of passports from all competitors must be available on request (national ID Card showing nationality, picture and date of birth or a copy is also accepted). The competitors don't need to be present at the nationality control.

Very important: Each National Federation must be represented by a team leader or coach responsible for registration of ALL athletes from the respective National Federation, regardless club or other membership. Every National Federation will be accepted for accreditation only once, when all entries and payments can be confirmed at the same time.

11. COMPETITION MODE AND REGULATIONS

Competition system: Elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.

The competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF and JUA.

12. DRAW

The draw will be conducted on Friday, July 14th, 2023 at 15:00 in Regal Riverside Hotel and supervised by the JUA Sports Commission.

Seeding: the top eight (8) from the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the current IJF World Ranking List. Each country may send two (2) delegates to the draw.

13. WEIGH-IN

Weigh-in will be the day before the competition at Regal Riverside Hotel and supervised by JUA officials.

Unofficial weigh-in: 16:00 to 16:30

Official weigh-in: 16:30 to 17:00

14. REFEREEING

Each National Federation may enter 2 referees with at least continental license. The organizing federation may enter a maximum of 4 referees with required classification.

JUDOBASE registration deadline for referees: Wednesday, July 5, 2023

The bow:

- The contestants must not shake hands BEFORE the start of the contest.
- When the athletes are leaving the mat they must wear judogi in proper way and are not allowed to take out any part of the judogi or the belt before leaving the field of play.

15. COACHING

All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.

Dress Code

Elimination Rounds: National track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or jacket suit with tie

Final Block: Jacket suit with tie

16. TRANSPORT

Airport: Hong Kong International Airport

Train Station: High Speed Rail: Hong Kong West Kowloon Station

Ferry Port: Hong Kong-Macau Ferry Pier

Cross-boundary Coach: Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Control Point

The organizer will provide transportation to the delegations hosted in official hotel free of charge, between the Airport / Train Station / Port and official hotel, and from official hotels to where the activities planned for the tournament take place.

17. ACCOMMODATION

All delegations, who inscribe for a JUA event should reserve their accommodation in the official hotels published in the event outlines. The reservation must be made with the local organising committee (not directly with the hotel). The organiser proposes the following official hotels:

All the rates are per person per night with breakfast only.

All other extra expenses including telephone, room service, laundry, mini bar, and etc., are the responsibility of the individual user.

Reservations of the official hotel must be booked exclusively through the organizer (Ms. CHAN at secretary@hkjudo.org). Rooms will be allocated on a first come - first served basis.

Hotel reservation deadline: Thursday, 1st June 2023

Delegates accommodated in non-official accommodation will have to pay Accreditation Fee 100€ per athlete and delegate.

Countries which cannot make bank transfers are entitled to pay in cash money upon arrival without any surcharge, if they inform the organizer and specify the number of participants before the accommodation reservation deadline.

Cancellations

Up to 30 days before arrival:	no charge
29 – 15 days before arrival:	50% refund
Less than 15 days:	no refund

IMPORTANT: Injuries, visa problems or sickness are not valid reasons for cancellation of rooms.

All damages to property of the hotel or venues resulting from the stay of a national delegation shall be charged to their federation and paid in full.

18. JUDOGI CONTROL

Approved Judogi

All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi (only red label allowed) and Judogis from all IJF suppliers are allowed (see www.ijf.org → Official Supplier List).

Judogi Control

It will be operated with a Sokuteiki prior to the fight. Judogi must have an IJF Official Label “APPROVED JUDOGI” with an optical code which cannot be falsified. The label will be controlled with an optical lamp. Each of the competition clothing articles (jacket, trousers and belt) must have an IJF official label.

Backnumber

Each competitor taking part in the JUA events is obliged to have sewn on the back of his Judogi the official backnumber (both JUA and IJF are allowed) bearing his surname and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation. 8 The backnumber can be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com or www.officialbacknumber.com (Attention: production and delivery may take around 4 weeks). The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.

Markings and Advertising

The space on the shoulder stripes (25cm x 5 cm on both right and left side) and on the **upper arms** (10cm x 10cm on both right and left side) can be either used for own sponsors of the Federation or Judoka or JUA Suppliers, **BUT not for any other Judogi supplier.**

The space on the right chest (5cm x 10cm) can be used by the Judoka for his/her own sponsor. The logo of a Judogi brand can only be used, if it corresponds with the brand of the Judogi itself and if it is an JUA Supplier. Further, no logo of a competing brand of the advertising reserved for the Federation can be used (unless approval granted by the Federation).

Please note: On all advertising spaces it is strictly prohibited to promote tobacco, alcohol, any substances listed in the doping code, or any product or service contrary to public morals.

The space on the left chest (10cm x 10cm) can be used for the national colours or the national emblem corresponding with the IOC code on the backnumber (regional emblems are not allowed).

Important:

- If an athlete does not respect the Judogi rules, the athlete will not be permitted to pass the Judogi Control, and the coach who is responsible for the athlete will be suspended for the rest of the competition day.
- The LOC is not obliged to provide reserve Judogi at Judogi Control, but the athlete is allowed to present himself in another IJF Approved Judogi, complying with the Sokuteiki rule (and without backnumber) - in this case no coach can go with this athlete to the mat!
- In the case of a repeated offence the coach will be suspended for the rest of the competition.

19. RESPONSIBILITY OF FEDERATIONS

The competitors will compete under the full responsibility of their federations. Insurance: Each national federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against “injury and third part risk (public liability)” during the period of the event. The Judo Union of Asia and the LOC decline all responsibility.

20. ANTI-DOPING

Anti-doping tests will be executed according to the IJF MEDICAL AND ANTI-DOPING HANDBOOK (IJF SOR – Appendix E).

21. TRAINING

Training schedules will be given upon accreditation at the official hotel.

Tatami for training will be available at Ma On Shan Sports Centre.

Thursday-Friday, July 13th – 14th, 2023: from 14:00 till 18:00

Booking of training sessions must be done in advance by email on or before June 15th, 2023: competition@hkjudo.org

Training on competition days in the sports hall warm up arena is NOT ALLOWED.
