The Pan American Judo Confederation (PJC), in collaboration with the Peruvian Judo Federation (Judo Peru) and with the support of Panam Sports, taking advantage of the occasion of the Cadet and Junior Pan American Cups being organized in Peru, is pleased to offer the second training camp exclusively dedicated to **JUNIOR** athletes. Below, you will find the guidelines for this camp.

#### 1. Dates:

Cadet Panamerican Cup	Wednesday, July 19th
Junior Panamerican Cup	Thursday, July 20th
Panamerican Open	Saturday, July 22nd and Sunday, July 23rd
Training Camp	From Monday, July 24th to Friday, July 28th

**Important Note:** For the training camp, all participants must comply with the COVID protocol set by the IJF and the host country, which is detailed in the regulations of the Pan American Open and the Lima 2023 Pan American Cups.

## 2. Participants and Support:

- Each National Federation or National Confederation member of PJC is invited to send 2 male Junior athletes, 2 female Junior athletes, and up to 2 coaches. It should include at least one female coach and one male coach.
- The cost of accommodation, meals, local transportation, and the camp for up to athletes and coaches will be covered free of charge, thanks to the support of Panam Sports and PJC. (Please confirm attendance as soon as possible, as there is a limit of 60 spots that will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis). # 3. Training Camp:

The camp will be led by the following coaches: **Yuri Alvear from Colombia (COL)** and **Marcelo Theotonio from Brazil (BRA)**.

Yuri Alvear is a highly decorated judoka who has won medals in various events, including the Olympic Games, Pan American Games, World Championships, and Pan American Championships. Her notable achievements include winning medals in two consecutive Olympic Games: a bronze medal in London 2012 and a silver medal in Rio de Janeiro 2016. She first won a medal at the World Championships in Rotterdam 2009, where she captured the gold medal and became a world champion. She achieved the same feat in Rio de Janeiro 2013 and Chelyabinsk 2014. In addition to her three world titles, Yuri Alvear also won three bronze medals at the Judo World Championships in Astana 2015, Budapest 2017, and Baku 2018. At the Pan American Games, she earned four medals: a bronze medal in Rio de Janeiro 2007 and Toronto 2015, and a silver medal in Guadalajara 2011 and Lima 2019.

Marcelo Theotonio started his journey in the Brazilian Judo Confederation in 2012 as an assistant coach for the junior teams and took over as the manager of the department in 2014. He led the process of identifying and developing young athletes until 2022. During this period, he played a direct role in obtaining 25 medals in the Junior World Championships (Under-21),





16 medals in the Cadet World Championships (Under-18), as well as two medals in the Youth Olympic Games and another 11 medals in the Junior Pan American Games in Cali 2021.

- The camp aims to provide junior athletes with the opportunity to improve their skills through specialized training sessions where they can acquire tactical knowledge that will help elevate their competitive level.
- The camp also aims to create a platform for coaches in this category, where they can share ideas with the camp's coaches and exchange knowledge with other coaches from the Americas.
- The Camp is the second event of its kind offered to junior athletes with a view towards the Los Angeles 2028 Olympic Games, and it serves as a means to start identifying talent from our continent in preparation for the mentioned Games.
- There will be two training sessions per day and presentations/workshops/discussions for the coaches.
- As part of Panam Sports' requirements, all athletes participating in this camp will undergo medical and laboratory examinations to assess their health conditions before and during the camp.

## 4. Registration and Dates:

- All interested Federations in accepting the invitation and support for their athletes and coaches in this camp must submit the form provided in these guidelines before **FRIDAY**, **JUNE 23, 2023.**
- The participation cost per additional person per night is 125.00 USD.
- All camp participants, whether athletes or officials, must be affiliated with the PJC, and their National Federation must be up to date with their PJC membership.
