This Asian Judo Open is open for all JUA / IJF Member Federations. There is no limit in the number of participation for each weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which enters them.

6. Categories & Duration of Contest:

Individual contests by weight categories

Male:

Up to and including 60kg (-60kg)

Over 60kg up to and including 66 kg (-66kg)

Over 66kg up to and including 73kg (-73kg)

Over 73kg up to and including 81kg (-81kg)

Over 81kg up to and including 90kg (-90kg)

Over 90kg up to and including 100kg (-100kg)

Over 100kg up (+100kg)

Female:

Up to and including 48kg (-48kg)

Over 48kg up to and including 52 kg (-52kg)

Over 52kg up to and including 57kg (-57kg)

Over 57kg up to and including 63kg (-63kg)

Over 63kg up to and including 70kg (-70kg)

Over 70kg up to and including 78kg (-78kg)

Over 78kg up (+78kg)

Golden Score: No time limit

7. JUDOBASE Registration

All participants and delegates must be registered for this event in the IJF Registration System (JUDOBASE): https://admin.judobase.org/

8. Accreditation & Control of Nationality

At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on November 24, 2023 (Friday) from 10:00 to 12:00 on time at the Hotel in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time, a nation will not be put into the draw and will not be allowed to compete. Each Head of Delegation must be present during the control of participants. Passports or photocopies of passports from all competitors must be available on request (national ID Card showing nationality and date of birth or a copy is also accepted). The competitors must not be present at the nationality control. An accreditation card with a photograph will be issued to competitors and officials.

9. Competition Mode

Competition system: Elimination (KO) system with the quarter-final (last 8) repechage. The competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF and JUA.

10. Draw

The draw will be taken place on November 24, 2023 (Friday) at 14:00 in Courtyard by Marriot. Each National Federation must send at least one (1) delegate to attend the draw. A maximum of two (2) delegates per National Federation will be authorized. The top eight (8) from the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the current IJF World Ranking List.

Dress code: Jacket suit with tie.

11. Weigh-in

Official weigh-in for each weight category will be held at designated timeslot 1 day before the competition day (see the program). The athlete must present his/her accreditation card. Passport and National ID Card showing his/her nationality and date of birth are also accepted.

Official scales will be available for try-out on Friday and Saturday from 09:00 – 22:00 (except the timeslot of official weigh-in).

Random weight checks with the same rules as the official weigh-in can be organized before the first contests in the morning of the competition. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5% higher (without Judogi) than the official maximum weight limit of the category.

12. Refereeing

Only referees with IJF International or Continental license can be entered. Each federation may enter a maximum of two (2) referees, the organizing federation may enter a maximum of four (4) referees with the same requirement as aforesaid. The meeting and training of the referees will be held on Friday immediate after the draw at Ma On Shan Sports Centre. For all referees the attendance at the referee meeting is strictly compulsory.

Dress code: White Judogi with Black Belt

13. Coaching

All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.

Dress Code:

Draw: Jacket suit and tie

Elimination rounds: National track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or jacket suit with tie

Final block: Jacket suit with tie

14. Transport:

Deadline for final reservation and full payment: November 6, 2023

-Cancellation fees: Up to 20 days before the hotel payment deadline, full refund. From 35 days before the arrival, 50% of the payment. On and after November 6, 2023, any cancellation, reduction of room number or no-show will result in 100% of the charge of the hotel costs that must be paid by the national federations. Cancellation of the rooms cannot be made at the check-in. Injuries, Visa problems or sickness are not valid reasons for the cancellation of rooms.

The competitors will compete under the full responsibility of their federations. Each national federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against "injury and third party risk (public liability)" during the period of the tournament. The Judo Union of Asia and the organizer decline all responsibility.
