7. PARTICIPATION:

This Asia Judo Championships 2024 is open for all JUA Member Federations/Associations. Each Federation/Association may enter a maximum of 2 (two) competitors per weight category, up to a total number of 9 men & 9 women. The competitors must be of the same Nationality as the National Federation/Association, which enters them.

All participants and delegates must be registered for this event in the IJF Registration System (JUDOBASE): https://admin.judobase.org/

Deadline for JUDOBASE Registration is 01 April 2024.

Any delegate is eligible to inscribe in the competition provided he/she is:

- •Not under a disciplinary suspension.
- •Not under suspension for anti-doping rule violation.
- Not under medical suspension.
- Healthy and fit for competition.
- •Do not carry any communicable diseases that may risk other delegates' health.
- Participating athletes must be born in 2009 (15 years old or over in the calendar year).
- •Sufficient technical knowledge (know the terminology and can execute all the techniques in the IJF SOR Appendix H) and understand fully the IJF sport and refereeing rules.

10. MIXED TEAM COMPETITION:

According to the IJF and JUA SOR, for mixed team competition, each team will consist of 6 (six) competitors (3 men and 3 women) and the weight categories should be as follows:

Men (3):

-73kg (up to and including 73kg)

-90kg (over 73kg up to and including 90kg)

+90kg (over 90kg)

Women (3):

-57kg (up to and including 57kg)

-70kg (over 57kg up to and including 70kg)

+70 kg (over 70kg)

Mixed team (6 categories)

Men: -73kg, -90kg, 90kg

Women: -57kg, -70kg, +70kg

11. ENTRY TO HOST COUNTRY:

The LOC will assist with visas where possible but having the correct visa is the responsibility of each participant. Visa applications will only be accepted for people who are inscribed in judobase for the event.

It is the responsibility of the National Federation to ensure that their delegation respects the conditions of stay defined by the Government of the country hosting the event. If any participant does not respect these conditions, any costs arising will be borne by the National Federation concerned.

Please note that visa approvals or rejections are done by the Government authorities and the LOC has no control over this and cannot be held responsible for any rejections.

12. ACCOMMODATION:

All delegations, who inscribe for an IJF WJT event, must reserve their accommodation in one of the official hotels published in the event outlines. The reservation must be made with the LOC (not directly with the hotel).

Any damage to hotel property resulting from the stay of a National Delegation will be charged to the National Federation and must be paid in full.

Delegations are kindly requested not to dry clothing (including judogi) or have training sessions in the corridors of the official hotels.

According to the IJF rule enacted on the 2 December 2012 in Tokyo, "the organising country should not request penalties fee for participating countries who cannot make bank transfers but can pay in cash upon arrival. Those countries who cannot make bank transfers should inform the LOC well in advance that they will pay cash on arrival".

13. INSCRIPTION FEES:

An inscription fee of US\$100 (one hundred) per weight category (Individual) and US\$500 (five hundred) per team (mixed team) must be paid to the JUA General Treasurer: JUDO UNION OF ASIA, at the time of accreditation. As a last resort these fees can be paid at the Delegation Meeting for the championships. After the Delegation Meeting, under no condition refunds can be given.

14. COMPETITION RULES:

Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JUA Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF Refereeing Rules.

System of competition: quarter-final (last 8) repechage, duration of contests: four (4) minutes (real time). The "Golden score" with no time limit.

The national federation is responsible for obtaining legal approval and permission for minor athletes to compete in competitions. When travelling with minors the team official/coach must have all the necessary documents in place that authorises them to act on behalf of the parents/guardians "in loco parentis".

This also applies to doping control. The national federation must ensure that minor athletes have their parental/guardian permission to undergo testing.

15. WEIGH-IN:

Weigh-in will be conducted one evening prior the event.

Athletes must present accreditation card, IJF ID card and his/her passport (National ID Card showing Nationality and date of birth are also accepted).

16. DRAW:

The draw will be held at 14:00 on 19 April in Oriental Regal Hotel.

Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the Draw, a maximum of two (2) delegates per National Federation (2 officials) will be authorized.

17. JUDOGI:

Approved Judogi

All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi.

Judogi Control

Judogi must have an IJF Official Label "APPROVED JUDOGI" with an optical code which cannot be falsified. The label can be controlled with an optical lamp. Each of the competition clothing articles (jacket, trousers and belt) must have an IJF official label.

National Emblem

Athletes can have their national emblem on the left front part of the jacket within a space of 100 cm2.

18. COACHING:

All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.

Dress Code:

Draw: Jacket suit with tie

Elimination rounds: National track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or jacket suit

with tie

Final block: Jacket suit with tie

19. AWARDS AND PRIZES

1st Place - Gold Medal with Diploma

2nd Place – Silver Medal with Diploma

3rd Place - Bronze Medal with Diploma

20. ANTIDOPING:

The Gold Medal Winner and another drawn Medalists from each weight category/mixed team medalists must undergo the doping control. Detailed guidelines and information can be found on the IJF website: http://www.ijf.org.
