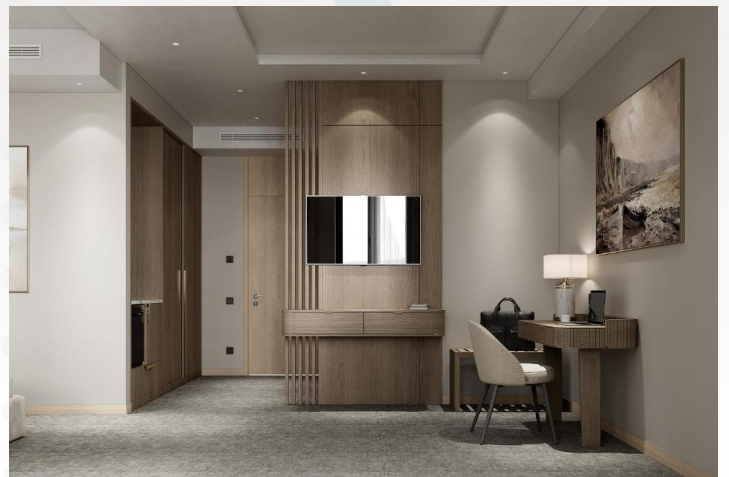

## 10. PARTICIPATION

All the participants must have valid IJF ID card, otherwise registration for this event is not possible. This JUA Cup Juniors is open for all JUA/IJF Member Federations. There is no limit in the number of participation for each weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which enters them. In case a Federation or a club registers an athlete with a different Nationality, a confirmation letter from the National Federation of the country of which the athlete holds the passport should be presented during the accreditation.

## 11. COMPETITION RULES

Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JUA Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF Refereeing Rules.

Men & Women – Four (4) minutes (Real Time)

The “Golden score” with no time limit. Referee’s decision is cancelled.

## 12. REFEREES

Each participating countries may enter TWO (2) referees at maximum. Referees must have IJF International or Continental Referee License.

## 13. WEIGH-IN

Weigh-in will be conducted one evening prior the event.

Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear and a T-shirt. Additional 100g will be allowed for their weight category limits.

Athletes must present accreditation card, IJF ID card and his/her passport (National ID Card showing nationality and date of birth are also accepted).

## 14. DRAW

The draw will be conducted online at 17:00 on 26 July in Uzbekistan Judo Federation office.

## 16. JUDOGI

### Approved Judogi

All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi.

### Judogi Control

It will be operated with a Sokuteiki prior to the fight. Judogi must have an IJF Official Label "APPROVED JUDOGI" with an optical code which cannot be falsified. The label can be controlled with an optical lamp. Each of the competition clothing articles (jacket, trousers and belt) must have an IJF official label.

### National Emblem

Athletes can have their national emblem on the left front part of the jacket within a space of 100cm<sup>2</sup>.

## 17. COACHING

Code of behavior of coaches as defined in the Sports and Organization Rules, Annex 4 will be strictly observed, inclusive the Dress Code.

- Coaches are not allowed to give indications to the competitors while they are fighting.
- Only during the pause time (after matte), coaches will be permitted to give indications to their athletes. - After the pause is finished, and the fight continues (hajime), coaches will have to keep silent again.
- If a coach doesn't follow these rules, they can be expelled from the competition area.
- If the coach persists with this behavior from outside the competition area, they could be penalized.

1st Place – Gold Medal with Diploma 2nd Place – Silver Medal with Diploma 3rd Place – Bronze Medal with Diploma
