4. Control of Entries and Accreditation

At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on or before **August 17 (Saturday) 12:00** in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time, a nation/club will not be put into the draw and will not be allowed to compete.

Passports or photocopies of passports from all competitors must be available on request (national ID Card showing nationality and date of birth or a copy is also accepted). An accreditation card with a photograph will be issued to competitors and officials.



5. Competition Rules

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF and JUA SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules.

Competition systems (according to number of participants):

6 and more entries: Elimination (KO) system with the quarter-final (last 8) repechage.

3, 4, 5 entries: Round robin

2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide

In order to an athlete to obtain points for the IJF Cadets Ranking List, her/his weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organizer's decision.

If, by the nominal deadline, there is only one country inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the National Federation concerned.

- Over 48 kg up to and including 52 kg (-52 kg)
- Over 52 kg up to and including 57 kg (-57 kg)
- Over 57 kg up to and including 63 kg (-63 kg)
- Over 63 kg up to and including 70 kg (-70 kg)
- Over 70kg (+70 kg)

6. Participant

Asian Cup Cadets & Junior Hong Kong 2024 is open for all JUA/IJF Member Federations. There is no limit in the number of participations for each weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which enters them.

Note: (1) Competitor can only be entered in one weight category
(2) Only entries of National Judo Federations – IJF members will be accepted

Contestants Age: Cadets:

Boys and Girls must be 15 to 17 years old
(must be born between 2007 and 2009)

Junior:

Men and Women must be 15 to 20 years old
(must be born between 2004 and 2009)

Reminders: For contestants under 18 years old, the secondary entry must be countersigned by their parent / guardian.

7. JUDOBASE Registration

All participants and delegates must be registered for this event in the IJF Registration System (**JUDOBASE**): <https://admin.judobase.org/>.

Deadline for JUDOBASE Registration is **Wednesday August 7, 2024**.

After the deadline, further registrations (late entries, replacements) are exclusively handled during accreditation according to the following rules:

Please note:

Above mentioned penalties must be paid in cash on spot.

Persons without IJF ID Card can only be entered on spot, if IJF ID Card will be ordered until end of Accreditation.

Persons, who are banned by their Federation cannot be entered as late entry or replacement.



8. Deadline for Application

- (a) Questionnaire: NO LATER THAN July 20, 2024
- (b) Hotel Reservation: NO LATER THAN July 20, 2024
- (c) Visa Application: NO LATER THAN July 15, 2024
- (d) Hotel Payment: NO LATER THAN July 22, 2024
- (e) Travel Schedule: NO LATER THAN July 22, 2024

All competitors, coaches and officials must be entered in time. After the deadline no additional persons can be added

9. Draw

- (a) The draw will be held on Saturday, August 17, 2024 at 14:00 in **B P International**.

The top eight (8) from the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the current IJF Cadets & Junior World Ranking List.

- (b) Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the Draw, a maximum of 2 delegates per National Federation will be authorized. The dress code for the draw is formal.

10. Weigh-in

The official weigh-in of athletes will be scheduled the day before the competition (see program). Athletes are not allowed to weigh in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls must wear at least underwear and a T-shirt. Additional 100g will be allowed for their weight category limits. Athletes must present an accreditation card and his/her passport (National ID Card Showing nationality and date of birth are also accepted).

Random weight checks of 4 (four) athletes per weight category (except for the + categories) with the same rules as the official weigh-in can be organized before the first fights in the morning of the competition. The athletes present their accreditation card. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5% higher (without judogi) than the official maximum weight limit of the category.

11. Referees

Team Referee: Each delegation may enter up to TWO (2) referees who hold JF International or Continental Referee License. The hotel accommodation (Twin room) would be covered by the LOC for the referees who come with the team. The organizing federation may enter a maximum of 4 referees with required qualification.

The Referee Meeting and Training will be held on **Saturday afternoon** (see program). The attendance to the Referee Meeting and Training is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.



12. Land Transportation:

15. Insurance:

Each National (Regional) Federation / Association will assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liability for their contestants and officials. The Judo Union of Asia, the Organizing Committee of the Asian Cup Cadets and Junior Hong Kong 2024, and The Judo Association of Hong Kong, China will not be responsible of any claims of illness, injury and death, of any participants/officials whatsoever. Nevertheless, the National (Regional) Federation / Association staging the Asian Cup Cadets and Junior Hong Kong 2024 shall take all necessary actions to provide insurance coverage against civil liability for the entire duration.



16. Judogi Control:

(a) Approved Judogi: All judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi.

(b) Judogi Control: It will be operated with a Sokuteiki prior to the fight. Judogi must have an IJF Official Label "APPROVED JUDOGEI" with an optical code which cannot be falsified. The label can be controlled with an optical lamp. Each of the competition clothing articles (jacket, trousers and belt) must have an IJF official label.

(c) Backnumber: Each competitor taking part in the JUA/IJF events is obliged to have sewn on the back of his Judogi the official IJF backnumber bearing his surname and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation.

(d) National Emblem: Athletes can have their national emblem on the left front part of the jacket within a space of 100cm².

17. Anti-Doping Control:

Doping control will be executed according to the IJF MEDICAL AND ANTI-DOPING HANDBOOK.

18. Visa:

Except for nationals of the designated countries, applicants can apply for visas at any PRC embassy, consulate or representative office. However, we suggest that applicants submit applications in the countries in which they reside. For any support, the Delegate should send copies of their passports as well as a letter including the passport details [Full name, Passport No, Date of Birth] to us not later than July 15, 2024
