Instructions for Downloading and Installing a .mcworld File

For PC Bedrock Edition

Step 1: Download the .mcworld File

1. **Download**: Click on the .mcworld file link. The download will begin and usually save to your Downloads folder.

Step 2: Import the Map into Minecraft

- 1. Locate the File: Open the Downloads folder and find the downloaded .mcworld file.
- 2. **Open the File**: Double-click on the .mcworld file. This will automatically launch Minecraft Bedrock Edition and start the import process.
- 3. **Confirmation**: Wait for the import to complete. A message will appear confirming the successful import.

Step 3: Play the Map

- 1. Launch Minecraft: If you still need to open, launch Minecraft Bedrock Edition.
- 2. Go to Play: Click on the Play button.
- 3. Find the Map: Look for the newly imported world in the list of available worlds.

For iOS

- 2. **Share to Minecraft**: Tap on the downloaded .mcworld file, then tap the Share button. Select Minecraft from the list of apps.
