

3. PARTICIPATION RULES AND INSCRIPTION OF DELEGATES

Please refer to the IJF Statutes Articles 8.7 and 8.8:

8.7 Representation of Member National Federations

Each Member National Federation may be represented at the Congress by two (2) delegates of the same nationality as that Federation who must mandatorily be chosen from among the members of their own Executive Committees, on the condition they were democratically elected by the clubs. They must be registered on the attendance sheet. Only one of them shall have the right to vote, as each Member National Federation shall have a single vote.

8.8 Credentials

Each delegate of a Member National Federation must be in possession of credentials in the form of a power of attorney signed by the President of their National Federation unless the delegate is the President himself. Delegates of Member National Federations must be citizens of the country of the Federation they represent.

All participating delegates must register via the following form: https://forms.gle/1wTNPuTQLoVVYN5m6 They also must have a valid IJF card and be inscribed in Judobase by their national federation.

ALL delegates MUST attend the Congress registration the day before the Congress. In case of unforeseen delay of arrival or changes/cancellation from the event the national federation must inform both the IJF (gs@ijf.org) and the LOC (office@judo.hu).

According to the IJF rule enacted on the 2 December 2012 in Tokyo, "the organising country should not request penalties fee for participating countries who cannot make bank transfers but can pay in cash upon arrival. Those countries who cannot make bank transfers should inform the LOC well in advance that they will pay cash on arrival".

If payment is being made by bank transfer the bank information must be inserted correctly and completely on the transfer document and any procedures related to amendment of the bank transfer must be done before arrival. Delegations must ensure that all bank charges are paid at their end so that the LOC receive the correct amount of funds without any deductions. Delegation must have proof of the bank transfer, upon arrival.

In the case of non-payment to the LOC, the national federation concerned will not be allowed to register to competitions until the debt is settled.
