





9. **DEADLINES**

Registration must be made through IJF registration system. Nations missing the registration will not be allowed to attend the event.

10. DIVISION

Individual contests by weight categories:

Men:

Up to and including 60kg (-60kg) Over 60kg up to and including 66 kg (-66kg) Over 66kg up to and including 73kg (-73kg) Over 73kg up to and including 81kg (-81kg) Over 81kg up to and including 90kg (-90kg) Over 90kg up to and including 100kg (-100kg) Over 100kg up (+100kg)

Women:

Up to and including 48kg (-48kg) Over 48kg up to and including 52 kg (-52kg) Over 52kg up to and including 57kg (-57kg)

12. COMPETITION RULES

Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JUA Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF Refereeing Rules.

13. NUMBER OF ENTRIES

There is no limit to the number of athletes from the same country that can be inscribed in a category.

14. WEIGH-IN:

- (a) The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the IJF/JUA SOR. The official weigh-in for athletes will be scheduled the day before the competition (see program for times).
- (b) The unofficial weigh-in will start 40 minutes before the official weigh-in and end 10 minutes before the official weigh-in. The official weigh-in period will be between 30 - 60 minutes, the exact times will be published in the event outlines.
- (c) Athletes are allowed to check their weight on the official weigh-in scales from 40 10 minutes before the official weigh-in commences. There is no limit to the number of times each athlete may check their weight during the time of the unofficial weigh-in.
- (d) The random weigh-in will open one hour before the start of the competition each day. The athletes must bring their accreditation for identification. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5% higher than the official maximum weight limit of the category

15. ELIGIBILITY

All participating delegates must have a valid IJF card and be inscribed in judobase (https://admin.judobase.org) by their National Federation by the event deadline. Any delegate is eligible to inscribe in the competition provided he/she is:

- Not under a disciplinary suspension.
- Not under suspension for anti-doping rule violation.
- Not under medical suspension.







- Healthy and fit for competition.
- Do not carry any communicable diseases that may risk other delegates' health.
- Participating athletes must be born between 2005 2010.
- Sufficient technical knowledge (know the terminology and can execute all the techniques in the IJF SOR Appendix H) and understand fully the IJF sport and refereeing rules.

16. REFEREES

Team Referee: Each delegation can enter TWO referee who holds JF International or Continental Referee License at maximum.

The hotel expense would be covered by the organizer for the referees who come with the team.

The minimum number of referees are 5 per mat, therefore 10 qualified referees will be required for two mats. Besides of the team referees, the JUA Head Referee Director will nominated 1 referee director, 2 referee commission members and qualified referees in order to guarantee the minimum number of referees for the competitions. The air fare, accommodation and per diem (daily allowance) of the above mentioned ITOs will be paid by the LOC.

17. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will be held under the control and supervision of the TD and JUA IT members appointed by the JUA Head Sports Director, from 09:00 to 14:00 on 21 May, 2025 in Uzbekistan Judo Federation and from 10:00 to 14:00 on 23 May, 2025 in the Venue.

Team leader or coach should bring the passports of the athletes and team officials for accreditation.

18. DRAW

The draw will be conducted online under the control and supervision of the TD and JUA IT members appointed by the JUA Head Sports Director, at 15:00 on 23 May, 2025 in Uzbekistan Judo Federation office.

19. NATIONALITY


Contestant must hold the same nationality of their Federation. Contestants are required to show his / her passport in order to confirm their nationality.

20. JUDOGI & BACKNUMBER

In accordance with the IJF and JUA regulations.







21. INSURANCE

Each National (Regional) Federation / Association will assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liability for their contestants and officials. The Judo Union of Asia, the Organizing Committee of the Tashkent Junior Asian Cup 2025 and the Uzbekistan Judo Federation will not be responsible of any claims of illness, injury and death, of any participants/officials whatsoever.

22. CEREMONIES

Contestants are required to attend the awarding ceremony in White Judogi with bare foot.

23. LAND TRANSPORT

The Organizer will provide land transportation from Tashkent International Airport or Tashkent Train Station to the official hotels and back. During the competitions, transportation will be provided between the venue and the hotel ONLY to accredited delegations.

24. METHODS OF COMPETITION

Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF Sports and Organization Rules, IJF Refereeing Rules and JUA Sports and Organization Rules.

25. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

The Anti-Doping Control will be carried out in accordance with the IJF Anti-Doping Rules and JUA Sports Organization Rules.
