3. Control of Entries and Accreditation:

At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on or before **July 18** (**Friday**) **12:00** in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time, a nation will not be put into the draw and will not be allowed to compete.

Passports or photocopies of passports from all competitors must be available on request (national ID Card showing nationality and date of birth or a copy is also accepted). An accreditation card with a photograph will be issued to competitors and officials.

4. Competition Rules:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules. Competition systems (according to number of participants):

6 and more entries: Elimination (KO) system with the quarter-final (last 8) repechage.

3, 4, 5 entries: Round robin

2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide

In order to an athlete to obtain points for the IJF Cadets/Junior Ranking List, her/his weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organizer's decision.

If, by the nominal deadline, there is only one country inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the National Federation concerned.

5. <u>Participant</u>:

Asian Cup Cadets & Junior Hong Kong 2025 is open for all JUA/IJF Member Federations. There is no limit in the number of participations for each weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which enters them.

Note: (1) Competitor can only be entered in one weight category

(2) Only entries of National Judo Federations – IJF members will be accepted

Contestants Age: Cadets:

Boys and Girls must be 15 to 17 years old (must be born between 2008 and 2010)

Junior:

Men and Women must be 15 to 20 years old (must be born between 2005 and 2010)

Reminders: For contestants under 18 years old, the secondary entry must be countersigned by their parent / guardian.

6. JUDOBASE Registration:

All participants and delegates must be registered for this event in the IJF Registration System (JUDOBASE): https://admin.judobase.org/

Deadline for JUDOBASE Registration is Friday July 4, 2025.

After the deadline, further registrations (late entries, replacements) are exclusively handled during accreditation according to the following rules:

Please note:

Above mentioned penalties must be paid in cash on spot.

Persons without IJF ID Card can only be entered on spot, if IJF ID Card will be ordered until end of Accreditation.

Persons, who are banned by their Federation cannot be entered as late entry or replacement.

7. Deadline for Application:

All competitors, coaches and officials must be entered in time. After the deadline no additional persons can be added.



8. <u>Draw</u>:

- (a) The draw will be held on Friday, July 18, 2025 at 14:00 in Regal Riverside Hotel.
 - The top eight (8) from the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the current IJF Cadets & Junior World Ranking List.
- (b) Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the Draw, a maximum of 2 delegates per National Federation will be authorized. The formal dressing is required for the draw.

9. Weigh-in:

The official weigh-in of athletes will be scheduled the day before the competition (see program). Athletes are not allowed to weigh in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls must wear at least underwear and a T-shirt. Additional 100g will be allowed for their weight category limits. Athletes must present accreditation card and his/her passport (National ID Card Showing nationality and date of birth are also accepted).

Random weight checks of 4 (four) athletes per weight category (except for the + categories) with the same rules as the official weigh-in can be organized before the first fights in the morning of the competition. The athletes present their accreditation card. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5% higher (without judogi) than the official maximum weight limit of the category.

10. Referees:

Each Federation may enter 2 referees. The organizing Federation may enter as many referees as required for the realization of the Tournament. The requirement in refereeing is at least the highest national license with at least 2 years of experience. The Referee Meeting and Training will be held **on Friday afternoon** (see program). The attendance to the Referee Meeting and Training is strictly compulsory. The referees should be in formal dressing for this meeting.

The bow:

The contestants must not shake hands BEFORE the start of the contest.

When the athletes are leaving the mat, they must wear judogi in proper way and are not allowed to take out any part of the judogi or the belt before leaving the field of play.

Special Refereeing Rules for Cadets:

Application of Kansetsu-Waza is allowed and should continue until Matte, tapping twice or the contestant is incapacitated by the effect of Kansetsu-Waza.

Application of shime waza is allowed. An athlete who has lost consciousness due to Shime Waza is not allowed to continue the competition.

11. Coaching:

Code of behaviour of coaches as defined in the Sports and Organization Rules, Annex 4 will be strictly observed, inclusive the Dress Code.

- -Coaches are not allowed to give indications to the competitors while they are fighting.
- -Only during the pause time (after matte), coaches will be permitted to give indications to their athletes.
- -After the pause is finished, and the fight continues (hajime), coaches will have to keep silent again.
- -If a coach doesn't follow these rules, they can be expelled from the competition area.
- -If the coach persists with this behavior from outside the competition area, they could be penalized.



12. Land Transportation:
