Hotel reservations are made ONLY through the Organizer on a first come first serve basis. The LOC will do their best to provide your first choice of accommodation but, as rooms might be limited, this cannot be guaranteed. Deadline final reservation and full payment: June 20, 2025

Cancellation fees: up to 20 days before the hotel payment deadline, full refund. From 35 days before the arrival 50% of the payment. After the <u>June 20, 2025</u> any cancellation of rooms reserved or no-show will result in 100% of the charge of the hotel costs that must be paid by the participating National Federation. Cancelations of the rooms cannot be made at the check-in. Injuries, visa problems or sickness are not valid reasons for cancellation of rooms.

IMPORTANT: All damages to property of hotels or venues resulting from the stay of a national delegation shall be charged to federation and paid in full.

9. COMPETITION RULES

Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JUA Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF Refereeing Rules.

10. NUMBER OF ENTRIES

There is no limit to the number of athletes from the same country that can be inscribed in a category.

11. WEIGH-IN:

- (a) The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the IJF/JUA SOR. The official weighin for athletes will be scheduled the day before the competition (see program for times).
- (b) The unofficial weigh-in will start 40 minutes before the official weigh-in and end 10 minutes before the official weigh-in. The official weigh-in period will be between 30 60 minutes, the exact times will be published in the event outlines.











- (c) Athletes are allowed to check their weight on the official weigh-in scales from 40 10 minutes before the official weigh-in commences. There is no limit to the number of times each athlete may check their weight during the time of the unofficial weigh-in.
- (d) The random weigh-in will open one hour before the start of the competition each day. The athletes must bring their accreditation for identification. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5 % higher than the official maximum weight limit of the category

12. ELIGIBILITY

All participating delegates must have a valid IJF card and be inscribed in judobase (https://admin.judobase.org) by their National Federation by the event deadline. Any delegate is eligible to inscribe in the competition provided he/she is:

- Not under a disciplinary suspension.
- Not under suspension for anti-doping rule violation.
- Not under medical suspension.
- Healthy and fit for competition.
- Do not carry any communicable diseases that may risk other delegates' health.
- Participating athletes must be 15, 16, 17 years old (born in 2008, 2009 and 2010).
- Sufficient technical knowledge (know the terminology and can execute all the techniques in the IJF SOR Appendix H) and understand fully the IJF sport and refereeing rules.

13. MINOR ATHLETES

The National Federation is responsible for obtaining legal approval and permission for minor athletes to compete in competitions. When travelling with minors the team official/coach must have all the necessary documents in place that authorizes them to act on behalf of the parents/guardians "in loco parentis".

14. REFEREES

Team Referee: Each delegation can enter ONE referee who holds JF International or

Continental Referee License at maximum.

The hotel expense would be covered by the organizer for the referees

who come with the team.

The minimum number of referees are 5 per mat, therefore 10 qualified referees will be required for two mats. Besides of the team referees, the JUA Head Referee Director will nominated 1 referee director, 2 referee commission members and qualified referees in order to guarantee the minimum number of referees for the competitions. The air fare, accommodation and per diem (daily allowance) of the above mentioned ITOs will be paid by the LOC.











15. NATIONALITY

Contestant must hold the same nationality of their Federation. Contestants are required to show his / her passport in order to confirm their nationality.

16. JUDOGI & BACKNUMBER

In accordance with the IJF and JUA regulations.

17. INSURANCE

Each National (Regional) Federation / Association will assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liability for their contestants and officials. The Judo Union of Asia, the Organizing Committee of the Almaty Cadet Asian Cup 2025 and the Kazakhstan Judo Federation will not be responsible of any claims of illness, injury and death, of any participants/officials whatsoever.

18. CEREMONIES

Contestants are required to attend the awarding ceremony in White Judogi with bare foot.

19. LAND TRANSPORT

The Organizer will provide land transportation from Almaty International Airport to the official hotels and back. During the competitions, transportation will be provided between the venue and the hotel ONLY to accredited delegations.

20. METHODS OF COMPETITION

Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF Sports and Organization Rules, IJF Refereeing Rules and JUA Sports and Organization Rules.

21. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

The Anti-Doping Control will be carried out in accordance with the IJF Anti-Doping Rules and JUA Sports Organization Rules.
