The worldwide activities of judo's veterans have been on the rise at national, international and even global level for several years now.

The 2023 World Veterans Championships, hosted by the United Arab Emirates Judo Federation from 31st October to 3rd November 2023, was yet another important step in the right direction.

852 participants from 31 countries competed for medals in Abu Dhabi and displayed amazing judo. The event was organised perfectly and generally received praise from all sides.









Furthermore, there were numerous tournaments and training events worldwide at national and continental level in 2023 and 2024. The veteran community is very well networked, with the judo value of friendship being of central importance.

From a global perspective, veteran judo is developing well, both in terms of sport and organisation.



The support of President Marius L. Vizer, the co-operation with the Executive Committee, the offices, the colleagues of all the commissions, as well as with the continental and national federations was and is outstanding and for this I would like to express my sincere gratitude.

The World Championships Veterans 2024 took place in Las Vegas, USA, from 4th to 7th November 2024. The number of participants increased once again with a total of 1132 judoka from 67 countries competing. The event in Las Vegas was organised brilliantly and met with a very positive response overall.







After taking a break due to coronavirus in 2020, the 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 championships saw a steady increase in the number of participants:
