### 7. Visa

#### PAY ATTENTION TO FRAUDULENT EMAILS! USE ONLY THE BANK DETAILS FROM THE OFFICIAL OUTLINES.

According to the new IJF rule enacted on the December 2, 2012 in Tokyo, country should not request fee penalties for countries which cannot make bank transfer but can pay in cash money upon

arrival. Those countries who cannot make bank transfers should inform the LOC well in advance that they will pay cash on arrival. On the other hand, they should inform well in advance the LOC and specify the number of participants before the deadline.

Cancellation fees: up to 20 days before the hotel payment deadline, full refund. After the 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2025 any cancellation of rooms reserved or no-show will result in 100% of the charge of the hotel costs that must be paid by the participating National Federation. Cancellations of the rooms cannot be made at the check-in. Injuries, visa problems or sickness are not valid reasons for cancellation or rooms.

\*All bank fees and bank transfer costs must be paid by the participating national federation. If payment is being made by bank transfer the bank information must be inserted correctly and completely on the transfer document and any procedures related to amendment of the bank transfer must be done before arrival. Delegations must ensure that all bank charges are paid at their end so that the LOC receive the correct amount of funds without any deductions. Delegation must have proof of the bank transfer, upon arrival.

Registration (entry) must be made through IJF Judobase.org registration system. Nations missing registration will not be allowed to attend the event.

### 10. Weigh-In

- (a) The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the IJF & JUA SOR
- (b) The athlete's official weigh in will be scheduled the day before the competition.
  - Unofficial weigh-in: 15:20 15:50 (the day before competition)
    - Official weigh-in: 16:00 16:30 (the day before competition)
- (c) First day weigh-in will be held in the Mungyeong STX Resort (Official hotel), and for the other days the weig h-in will be carried out in the Stadium.
- (d) Random weigh-in will take place one hour before the start of the competition each day until appx. 30 minu tes before the athlete's first contest at the latest. The athletes must bring their accreditation for identificati on. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5% higher than the official maximum weight limit of the category.

Men and Women under 21, age 15 to 20 years (Calendar year). (Must be born between 2005 to 2010)

Reminders: For contestants under 18-year-old, the final entry must be countersigned by parent/guardian.

### 14. Entries

Three participants from three different member federations must compete in a category in order that the championship for that category to be held.

In Cadets (Boys and Girls under 18) - each National Federation may enter 10 entries in total for boys and 10 entries for girls. Only a maximum of two athletes per category for boys and the same for girls will be allowed. The total delegation of both boys and girls are maximum of 20 athletes. There has no open category.

In Juniors (men and women under 21) - each National Federation may enter 9 entries in total for men and 9 entries for women. Only a maximum of two athletes per category for men and the same for women will be allowed. The total delegation of both men and women are maximum of 18 athletes. There has no open category.

All entries for competitors must be made through IJF Judo base registration system.

All participants and delegates must be registered for this event in the IJF Registration System (JUDOBASE): https://admin.judobase.org/

Deadline for JUDOBASE Registration is 20<sup>th</sup> August 2024.

After the deadline, further registrations (late entries, replacements) are exclusively handled during accreditation according to the following rules:

### **15. Inscription fees**

An inscription fee of US\$ 100 (hundred) per weight category must be paid to the JUA General Treasurer: JUDO UNION OF ASIA, at the time of accreditation. As a last resort these fees can be paid at the Delegation Meeting for the championships. After the Delegation Meeting, under no condition refunds can be given.

### 16. Draw

The draw will be held on Wednesday, September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 14:00 at Artotel Gelora Senayan under the control of the JUA Sports Director. Each Member Federation must send a delegate to attend the draw; a maximum of 2 delegates per Federation will be authorized. The dress code for draw is formal.

### 17. Competition Mode and Regulations

**Competition system:** Elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage. Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JUA Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF Refereeing Rules.

### 18. Referees

**Team Referee:** Each delegation can enter ONE referee (air fare will be covered by each team, and accommodation will be covered by the host country) who must hold at least an IJF International or Continental Referee License. In case the number of team accompanied referee is less than ten, to guarantee the smooth running of the championships, the remaining number of referees will be appointed by the JUA Head Referee Director, and the air ticket, accommodation and per diem for the appointed referees will be covered by the host country.

### 19. Nationality

Contestant must hold the same nationality of their Federation. Contestants are required to show his / her passport to confirm their nationality.

### 20. Judogi & Backnumber

In accordance with the IJF and JUA regulations.

### 21. Training

Training schedules will be given upon accreditation at the official hotel. Tatami for training will be available at the Artotel Gelora Senayan. 09 – 12 September, 2025 : from 10:00 till 18:00 Booking of training sessions must be done in advance by email: International relation.inajudo@gmail.com

### 22. Responsibility of Federations

The competitors will compete under the full responsibility of their federations. Insurance: Each national federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against "injury and third part risk (public liability)" during the period of the event. The Judo Union of Asia and the LOC decline all responsibility.

### 24. Land Transportation
