Payment method – Bank transfer or cash (in USD) According to the IJF rule enacted on the 2 December 2012 in Tokyo, "the organising country should not request penalties fee for participating countries who cannot make bank transfers but can pay in cash upon arrival. Purpose of Transfer	AO2025

If payment is being made by bank transfer the bank information must be inserted correctly and completely on the transfer document and any procedures related to amendment of the bank transfer must be done before arrival. Delegations must ensure that all bank charges are paid at their end so that the LOC receive the correct amount of funds without any deductions. Delegation must have proof of the bank transfer, upon arrival. In the case of non-payment to the LOC, the national federation concerned will not be allowed to register to competitions until the debt is settled.

Registration must be made through IJF registration system by November 14, 2025. Nations missing the registration will not be allowed to attend the event.

8. DIVISION

Individual contests by weight categories:

- Men:
- Up to and including 60kg (-60kg)
 - Over 60kg up to and including 66 kg (-66kg)
 - Over 66kg up to and including 73kg (-73kg)
 - Over 73kg up to and including 81kg (-81kg)
 - Over 81kg up to and including 90kg (-90kg)
 - Over 90kg up to and including 100kg (-100kg)
 - Over 100kg (+100kg)
- Women:
- Up to and including 48kg (-48kg)
 - Over 48kg up to and including 52 kg (-52kg)
 - Over 52kg up to and including 57kg (-57kg)
 - Over 57kg up to and including 63kg (-63kg)
 - Over 63kg up to and including 70kg (-70kg)
 - Over 70kg up to and including 78kg (-78kg)
 - Over 78kg (+78kg)

9. COMPETITION RULES

Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JUA Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF Refereeing Rules.



10. NUMBER OF ENTRIES

There is no limit to the number of athletes from the same country that can be inscribed in a category.

11. WEIGH-IN:

- (a) The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the IJF/JUA SOR. The official weigh-in for athletes will be scheduled the day before the competition (see program for times).
- (b) The unofficial weigh-in will start 40 minutes before the official weigh-in and end 10 minutes before the official weigh-in. The official weigh-in period will be between 30 - 60 minutes, the exact times will be published in the event outlines.
- (c) Athletes are allowed to check their weight on the official weigh-in scales from 40 - 10 minutes before the official weigh-in commences. There is no limit to the number of times each athlete may check their weight during the time of the unofficial weigh-in.
- d) The random weigh-in will open one hour before the start of the competition each day. The athletes must bring their accreditation for identification. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5 % higher than the official maximum weight limit of the category.

12. EVENT MANAGEMENT

The competitions will be conducted and run by the Sports and IT Team under the guidance of the TD appointed by the JUA Head Sports Director. According to the JUA EOR, the JUA Head Sports Director will nominate 1 TD, 2 Sports Commission members or JUA Organizing Experts and 2 IT members to conduct and run the draw and competitions. The air fare, accommodation and per diem (daily allowance) of the above mentioned ITOs will be paid by the LOC.

13. ELIGIBILITY

All participating delegates must have a valid IJF card and be inscribed in judobase (<https://admin.judobase.org>) by their National Federation by the event deadline.

Any delegate is eligible to inscribe in the competition provided he/she is:

- Not under a disciplinary suspension.
- Not under suspension for anti-doping rule violation.
- Not under medical suspension.
- Healthy and fit for competition.
- Do not carry any communicable diseases that may risk other delegates' health.
- Participating athletes must be born in 2010 or before.
- Sufficient technical knowledge (know the terminology and can execute all the techniques in the IJF SOR Appendix H) and understand fully the IJF sport and refereeing rules.



14. REFEREES

Team Referee: Each delegation can enter ONE referee who holds IJF International or Continental Referee License at maximum. The hotel expense would be covered by the organizer for the referees who come with the team.

The minimum number of referees are 5 per mat, therefore 10 qualified referees will be required for two mats. Besides of the team referees, the JUA Head Referee Director will be nominated 1 referee director, maximum 2 referee commission members and qualified referees in order to guarantee the minimum number of referees for the competitions. The airfare, accommodation and per diem (daily allowance) of the above mentioned ITOs will be paid by the LOC.

15. NATIONALITY

Contestant must hold the same nationality of their Federation. Contestants are required to show his / her passport in order to confirm their nationality.

16. JUDOGI & BACKNUMBER

In accordance with the IJF and JUA regulations.

17. INSURANCE

Each National (Regional) Federation / Association will assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liability for their contestants and officials. The Judo Union of Asia, the Organizing Committee of the Hong Kong Asian Judo Open 2025 and The Judo Association of Hong Kong, China will not be responsible of any claims of illness, injury and death, of any participants/officials whatsoever.

18. CEREMONIES

Contestants are required to attend the award ceremony in White Judogi with bare foot.

19. LAND TRANSPORT

The Organizing Committee will provide transport for the delegations and JUA officials from the Airport to the Hotel upon arrival and from the Hotel to Airport on departure, and during the competition between the hotel, the venue and training hall.

20. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

The Anti-Doping Control will be carried out in accordance with the IJF Anti-Doping Rules and JUA Sports Organization Rules.
