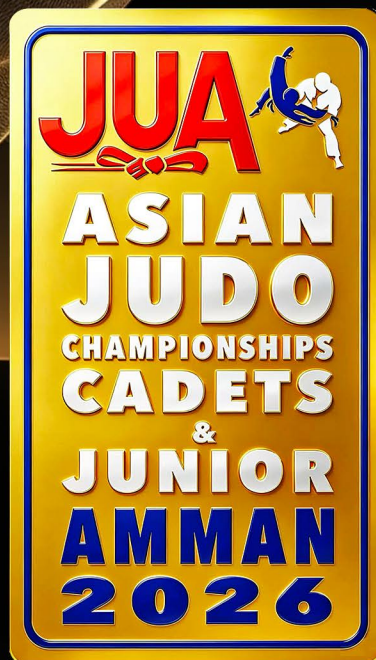

7. Visa

The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) will provide official documentation, such as invitation letters or confirmation of participation, for the participating teams and officials. Each National Federation is responsible for ensuring that their delegation complies with the visa requirements of the host country.

* Entry letters and visa applications will only be accepted for people who are inscribed in judobase. Registration (entry) must be made through IJF Judobase.org registration system. Nations missing registration will not be allowed to attend the event.

10. Weigh-In

- The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the IJF & JUA SOR
- The athlete's official weigh in will be scheduled the day before the competition.
 - **Unofficial weigh-in: 15:20 - 15:50 (the day before competition)**
 - **Official weigh-in: 16:00 - 16:30 (the day before competition)**
- The random weigh-in will open 45 minutes before the start of the competition each day until 15 minutes before the start of the competition. The athletes must bring their accreditation for identification. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5 % higher than the official maximum weight limit of the category.

11. Eligibility

For the Member Federations & Associations of the Judo Union of Asia.

All athletes must have a valid IJF card and be inscribed in judobase (<https://admin.judobase.org>) by their National Federation by the event deadline.

Any athlete is eligible to inscribe in the competition provided he/she is:

- Not under a disciplinary suspension.
- Not under suspension for anti-doping rule violation.
- Not under medical suspension.
- Healthy and fit for competition.
- Do not carry any communicable diseases that may risk other delegates' health.
- Sufficient technical knowledge (know the terminology and can execute all the techniques in the IJF SOR Appendix H) and understand fully the IJF sport and refereeing rules.

Duration of contest: 4 minutes **Golden Score:** No time limit

13. Age

Cadets

Men and Women under 18, age 15, 16 and 17 years (Calendar year).
(Must be born between 2009, 2010, and 2011)

Junior

Men and Women under 21, age 15 to 20 years (Calendar year).
(Must be born between 2006 to 2011)

Reminders: For contestants under 18-year-old, the final entry must be countersigned by parent/guardian.

14. Entries

Three participants from three different member federations must compete in a category in order that the championship for that category to be held.

In Cadets (Boys and Girls under 18) - each National Federation may enter 10 entries in total for boys and 10 entries for girls. Only a maximum of two athletes per category for boys and the same for girls will be allowed. The total delegation of both boys and girls are maximum of 20 athletes. There has no open category.

In Juniors (men and women under 21) - each National Federation may enter 9 entries in total for men and 9 entries for women. Only a maximum of two athletes per category for men and the same for women will be allowed. The total delegation of both men and women are maximum of 18 athletes. There has no open category.

All entries for competitors must be made through IJF Judo base registration system.

15. Inscription fees

An inscription fee of **US\$ 150 (one hundred fifty)** per weight category must be paid to the JUA General Treasurer: JUDO UNION OF ASIA, at the time of accreditation. As a last resort these fees can be paid at the Delegation Meeting for the championships. After the Delegation Meeting, under no condition refunds can be given.

16. Draw

The draw will be held on **Wednesday, 15th July 2026, at 14:00 at Grand Palace Hotel** under the control of the JUA Head Sports Director. Each Member Federation must send a delegate to attend the draw; a maximum of 2 delegates per Federation will be authorized. The dress code for draw is formal.

17. Competition Mode and Regulations

Competition system: Elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage. Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JUA Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF Refereeing Rules.

18. Referees

Referees will be appointed by the JUA Head Referee Director, and no team referee is allowed.

19. Nationality

Contestant must hold the same nationality of their Federation. Contestants are required to show his/her passport to confirm their nationality.

20. Judogi & Backnumber

In accordance with the IJF and JUA regulations.

21. Training

Training schedules will be given upon accreditation at the official hotel.

14 – 18 July, 2026 : from 10:00 till 18:00

Booking of training sessions must be done in advance by email: Internationalrelation.inajudo@gmail.com

22. Responsibility of Federations

The competitors will compete under the full responsibility of their federations.

Insurance: Each national federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against “injury and third part risk (public liability)” during the period of the event. The Judo Union of Asia and the LOC decline all responsibility.

23. Anti-Doping Control

The Anti-Doping Control will be carried out in accordance with the IJF Anti-Doping Rules and JUA Sports Organization Rules.

24. Land Transportation

The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) will provide transport from the Airport to the Hotel upon arrival and from the Hotel to Airport on departure. During the Asian Cadet & Junior Judo Championships, transportation will be provided between the venue and hotels at predetermined times and schedules.
