## General Information & Regulation

### 1. Organizer:

#### JUDO UNION OF ASIA

The Asian Judo Cup Cadets and Junior are IJF and JUA ranking events open for all IJF/JUA Member Federations. The running of competitions will be conducted under the control and guidance of JUA appointed TD, IT members and Officials (ITOs). The air fare, accommodation and per diem (daily allowance) of the above-mentioned TD and ITOs will be paid by the LOC.

### 4. Control of Entries and Accreditation:

At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on **July 17 (Friday) 09:00 to 12:00** in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time, a nation/region will not be put into the draw and will not be allowed to compete.

Passports or photocopies of passports from all competitors must be available on request (national ID Card showing nationality and date of birth or a copy is also accepted). An accreditation card with a photograph will be issued to competitors and officials.

### 5. Competition Rules:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF and JUA SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules.

Competition systems (according to number of participants):

6 and more entries: Elimination (KO) system with the quarter-final (last 8) repechage.

3, 4, 5 entries: Round robin

2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide

In order to an athlete to obtain points for the IJF Cadets/Junior Ranking List, her/his weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organizer's decision.

If, by the nominal deadline, there is only one country inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the National Federation concerned.

## 6. Eligibility:

All participating athletes and officials must have a valid IJF card and be inscribed in judobase by their National Federation by the event deadline (<https://admin.judobase.org>).

Any athlete is eligible to inscribe in the competition provided he/she is:

- Not under a disciplinary suspension.
- Not under suspension for anti-doping rule violation.
- Not under medical suspension.
- Healthy and fit for competition.
- Do not carry any communicable diseases that may risk other delegates' health.
- Participating athletes must be born in 2009 or before.
- Sufficient technical knowledge (know the terminology and can execute all the techniques in the IJF SOR Appendix H) and understand fully the IJF sport and refereeing rules.

There is no limit in the number of participants for each weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which enters them.

## 8. Participant:

Asian Cup Cadets & Junior Hong Kong 2026 is open for all JUA/IJF Member Federations. There is no limit in the number of participations for each weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which enters them.

**Note:** (1) Competitor can only be entered in one weight category  
(2) Only entries of National Judo Federations – JUA/IJF members will be accepted

### Contestants Age:

**Cadets:** Boys and Girls must be 15 to 17 years old (must be born between 2009 and 2011)

**Junior:** Men and Women must be 15 to 20 years old (must be born between 2006 and 2011)

Reminders: For contestants under 18 years old, the secondary entry must be countersigned by their parent / guardian.

## 9. JUDOBASE Registration:

All participants and delegates must be registered for this event in the IJF Registration System (**JUDOBASE**): <https://admin.judobase.org/>  
Deadline for JUDOBASE Registration is **Friday July 3, 2026.**

**Please note:**

Above mentioned penalties must be paid in cash on spot.

Persons without IJF ID Card can only be entered on spot, if IJF ID Card will be ordered until end of Accreditation.

Persons, who are banned by their Federation cannot be entered as late entry or replacement.

**10. Deadline for Application:**

- (a) Questionnaire: NO LATER THAN June 12, 2026
- (b) Hotel Reservation: NO LATER THAN June 12, 2026
- (c) Visa Application: NO LATER THAN June 12, 2026
- (d) Hotel Payment: NO LATER THAN June 19, 2026
- (e) Travel Schedule: NO LATER THAN June 19, 2026

All competitors, coaches and officials must be entered in time. After the deadline no additional persons can be added.

**11. Draw:**

- (a) The draw will be held on Thursday, Friday 17, 2026 at 14:00 in **Courtyard by Marriott**.  
The top eight (8) from the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the current IJF Cadets & Junior World Ranking List.
- (b) Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the Draw, a maximum of 2 delegates per National Federation will be authorized. The dress code for the draw is formal.

**12. Weigh-in:**

**The official weigh-in of athletes will be scheduled the day before the competition** (see program). Athletes are not allowed to weigh in naked. For cadets men must wear at least underwear and women must wear at least underwear and a T-shirt. Additional 100g will be allowed for their weight category limits. Athletes must present accreditation card and his/her passport (National ID Card Showing nationality and date of birth are also accepted).

**Random weight checks** of 4 (four) athletes per weight category (except for the + categories) with the same rules as the official weigh-in can be organized before the first fights in the morning of the competition. The athletes present their accreditation card. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5% higher (without judogi) than the official maximum weight limit of the category.

## 13. Referees:

Each Federation may enter 2 referees. The organizing Federation may enter four, in the situation of number of team referees less than ten, then the organizer may allow the host federation to enter more referees as required for the realization of the Tournament. The requirement in refereeing is at least holder of IJF international and/or continental referee license. The Referee Meeting and Training will be held **on Friday afternoon** (see program). The attendance to the Referee Meeting and Training is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.

## 14. Coaching:

Code of behaviour of coaches as defined in the IJF/JUA Sports and Organization Rules, Annex 4 will be strictly observed, inclusive the Dress Code.

## 15. Land Transportation:

However, we suggest that applicants submit applications in the countries in which they reside.
